


Figure 1: Forecasted Seven-Day total rainfall valid 9th to 15th Dec 2025

Rainfall is expected over few parts of the county during the forecast period, as shown in fig. 1 below

Key to rainfall distribution symbols: rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%), rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%), rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- Morning sessions: Mainly sunny intervals to dominate during the forecast period.
- Afternoon sessions Few parts of the county are likely to receive light to moderate rainfall during the forecast period. Light rainfall over few places is likely on Wednesday, Friday and Monday. Moderate rainfall over few places is likely on Thursday.
- **Nights**: Partly cloudy conditions are expected during the forecast period.
- Maximum temperature ranges likely to be 28-29°C whereas minimum temperatures range likely to be 12°- 16°C during the forecast period
