


Figure 1: Nyamira climate zones

# NYAMIRA COUNTY WEATHER SUMMARY AND ADVISORIES

#### I. General Weather Outlook

Rainfall is anticipated to commence on the morning of Friday, December 12, 2025, across most regions of Nyamira County.

#### **Weather Pattern:**

• Overall: Predominantly sunny conditions are expected from Tuesday, December 9, to Thursday, December 11, 2025. Following this period, light to moderate rain will begin on Friday morning, transitioning into afternoon and evening showers accompanied by thunderstorms. This weather pattern is expected to persist until Monday, December 15, 2025.

#### II. Temperature Forecast

- Maximum Daytime Temperature: Ranges from 20°C to 30°C
- Minimum Nighttime Temperature: Ranges from 12°C to 17°C

## **III. Sector-Specific Advisories**

- Agricultural Advisory: Farmers are encouraged to liaise with the Departments of Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries, and Cooperative Development for guidance on suitable agricultural practices during this period.
- **Residents Advisory:** Residents are advised to refrain from seeking shelter under trees and to avoid outdoor activities during rainfall to mitigate the risk of lightning strikes.
- Motorists & Pedestrians Advisory: Motorists and pedestrians should exercise caution
  while using the roads during the rainy season, particularly from Friday through Monday,
  to reduce the likelihood of road accidents.
- **General Advisory:** The anticipated showers and thunderstorms may occasionally be accompanied by strong winds and hailstorms.

#### IV. Recommendations

Residents are urged to stay informed and take appropriate precautions in light of the forecasted weather conditions.
