



Key to rainfall distribution:

FEW- : Rain is likely to fall in few places (0% to less than 33%),

SEVERAL- : Rainfall is likely to fall in several places (33% to less than 66%),

MOST- : Rainfall is likely to fall in most places (More than 66%).

Summary

- ➤ The above figure shows the weekly cummulative volume of rainfall amounts each ward and/or sub-county in Nakuru County is forecasted to receive from Tuesday 9th to Monday 15th December 2025.
- ➤ Detailed forecast in the above Climatic Zone tables indicates that much of the County is projected to receive cumulative weekly rainfall of less than 1mm. Some parts of Kuresoi, Njoro, Bahati, Gilgil and Naivasha sub counties may, however, receive between 1mm and 10mm cumulatively (refer to the map legend for details).
- ➤ All the wards are projected to receive morning light rains as well as afternoon and night showers over few places. Areas over large water bodies like lakes Naivasha and Nakuru (and their environs which includes the city and Naivasha town) may experience some afternoon rainfall activities due to local climatological effects.
- ➤ Kindly refer to the above map and tables for details of projected weather outlook as well as weekly cumulative amounts of rainfall during the forecast period.

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- Sunny intervals with rains over few places in the morning hours.
- Showers and thunderstorms over few places in the afternoon/evening during the forecast period.
- Partly cloudy night conditions expected during the forecast period.

Advice to farmers from the Ministry & Department of Agriculture:

Highly consider to always consult your local agricultural extension officer for advice on how to plan farming activities in light of this forecast.
