

BUSIA COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST



Period of forecast: Tuesday 16th December to Monday 22nd December 2025

Date of issue: Monday 15th December 2025

Summary

Sunny intervals are expected in the mornings, though occasional rain may occur in a few places. Isolated afternoon showers accompanied with lightning, occasional strong wind and hailstones are expected over a few places, occasionally spreading to several places. Night showers are likely to occur over a few places.

Maximum and minimum temperatures will be lower than last week. Expect afternoon highs of 25°C to 28°C and dawn lows of 16°C to 18°C.



Key to rainfall space distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in **few places** (less than 33%, 0% inclusive),  rain is likely to fall in **many/several places** (33-67%),  rain is likely to fall in **most places** (more than 67%).

Commentary of County Weather Forecaster:

- There is a chance of receiving rains during the forecast period over few places, occasionally spreading to several places.
- Harvest rainwater and store it safely for future use.
- In case you hear thunder or see lightning, find shelter inside a building. Stay away from windows and doors.
- Protect your animals from cold rain and the risk of lightning strikes, strong wind or hail by bringing them indoors when it rains.
- The current rains are shortlived and are likely subside after 23nd or 24th December 2025.
- Use the rains to plant cowpeas for use during the dry period ahead.
- Top dress your crops when the soil is wet.
