

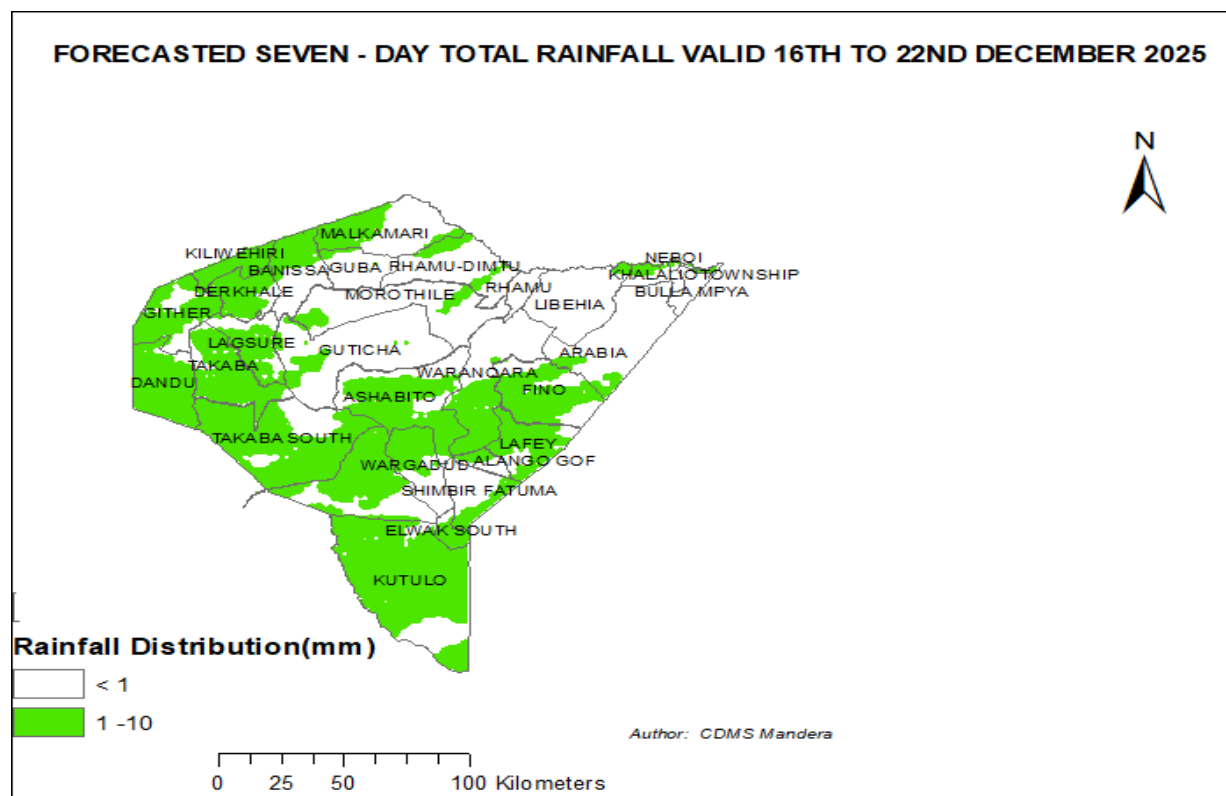

General Outlook/Summary

Reduction in rainfall amount in Dandu, Kutulo sub counties wards, Ashabito, Kiliwehiri, lafey, Kutulo, Mandera west, Mandera South sub counties wards. Khalalio, Mandera North, Mandera East sub counties are expected to receive some amount of rainfall, the rest will likely be sunny and dry throughout the forecast period.
