SIAYA COUNTY CLIMATOLOGICAL MAP

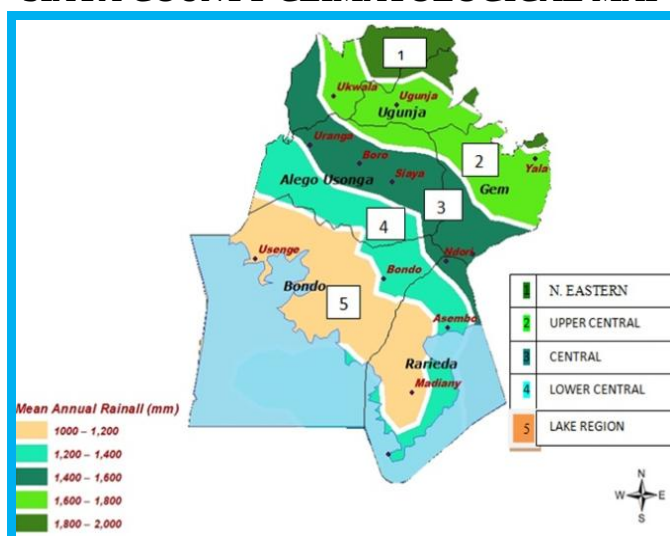


Figure 1; Siaya County Long Term Mean rainfall (Climatological) Map

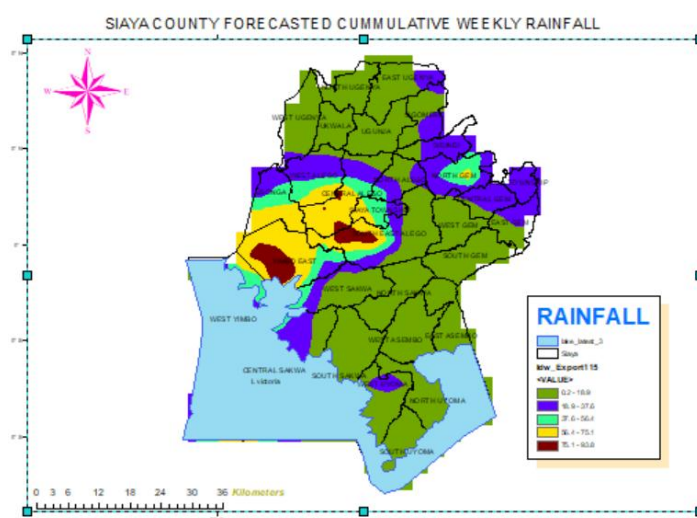


Figure 2: Forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall from 16TH Dec. to 22ND Dec. 2025

Figure 2 above shows the map for forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall ranging between 0.2mm and 93.8mm. Most parts of the County are expected to receive between 0.2mm and 18.9mm of rainfall. Some parts of the County eg S. E. Alego, N. Gem, Yimbo East, C. Alego, Siaya Township, and N. Gem wards are likely to experience between 56.4mm and 93.8mm cumulatively

Period of forecast: Tuesday 16th December to Monday 22nd December 2025

Date of issue: Monday 15th December 2025

Summary of The Forecast

Regions; 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5; Morning showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely on Monday. Afternoon/night showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely throughout the forecast period except on Tuesday. Temperatures of between 26°C and 25°C during the day and between 20°C and 18°C during the night likely. Moderate to Strong winds more so over Lake Victoria likely throughout the forecast period

- Mosquito protection; Ensure you sleep under mosquito net or use repellent
- Proper hygiene; Maintain good personal hygiene i.e use of toilet and proper washing of hands with clean water.
- Secure valuables and drugs; Safeguard important documents and drugs
- Stay informed; Stay updated on weather forecast and follow official advisories for real time information
