

GENERAL OUTLOOK

Morning sea state:

Light and variable predominantly N winds 02-06knots with smooth seas. E to ESE waves of 3ft (0.9m) with small short period waves of (7-8sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Afternoon sea state:

• Light to breezy E to ESE winds (07-12knots) with slight to moderate choppy seas. ENE to ESE waves of 2-3feet (0.6-0.9m) with small to mid-period waves of (8-10sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Visibility:

 Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST

i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: NW 3 knots.
- Morning Waves: E 3 feet at 7 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 10 to 12 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 2 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy ENE winds with moderate choppy seas. Very small mid period waves.
- Sunrise; 6.07AM and sunset; 6:31PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10 km)
- High Tide: 3:36AM; 3.43m, 4:05PM;2.81m
 Low Tide: 10:06AM; 0:58m, 9:51PM; 0.78m

ii. MOMBASA

- Morning Winds: NNE 2 to 3 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 3 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 8 to 10 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: E 3 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light E winds with a slight chop. Very small short period waves.
- Sunrise; 6.07AM and sunset; 6:29PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10 km)
- High Tide: 3:42AM; 3.29m, 4:11PM;2.7m
- Low Tide: 10.08AM; 0.59m, 9:52PM; 0.79m

iii. KILIFI

- Morning Winds: E 6 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 3 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light E winds with slight chop seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 9 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: E 3 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light E winds with slight chop seas. Very small short period waves.
- Sunrise; 6.07AM and sunset; 6:28 PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 3:33AM; 3m, 4.05PM; 2.43m
- Low Tide: 10:02AM; 0.37m, 9:47 PM; 0.62m

iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: S 2 to 3 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 3 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves
- Afternoon Winds: ESE 7 to 11 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 3 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light ESE winds with a slight chop. Very small short period wave.
- Sunrise; 6:05AM and Sunset; 6:21PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 3:33AM; 2.89m, 4.06PM; 2:3m
- Low Tide: 10.05AM; 0.35m, 9:47PM; 0.59m

Advisory

- Slight to moderate sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of (0.6-0.9m) in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Calm to gentle breeze of (02-12knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa Kilifi and Lamu throughout the forecast period.

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 6 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7-17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 - ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!!
