WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST

Date of forecast issue: Monday 22nd Dec 2025

Period of forecast: Tuesday 23rd to Monday 29th Dec 2025

General Outlook/Summary.

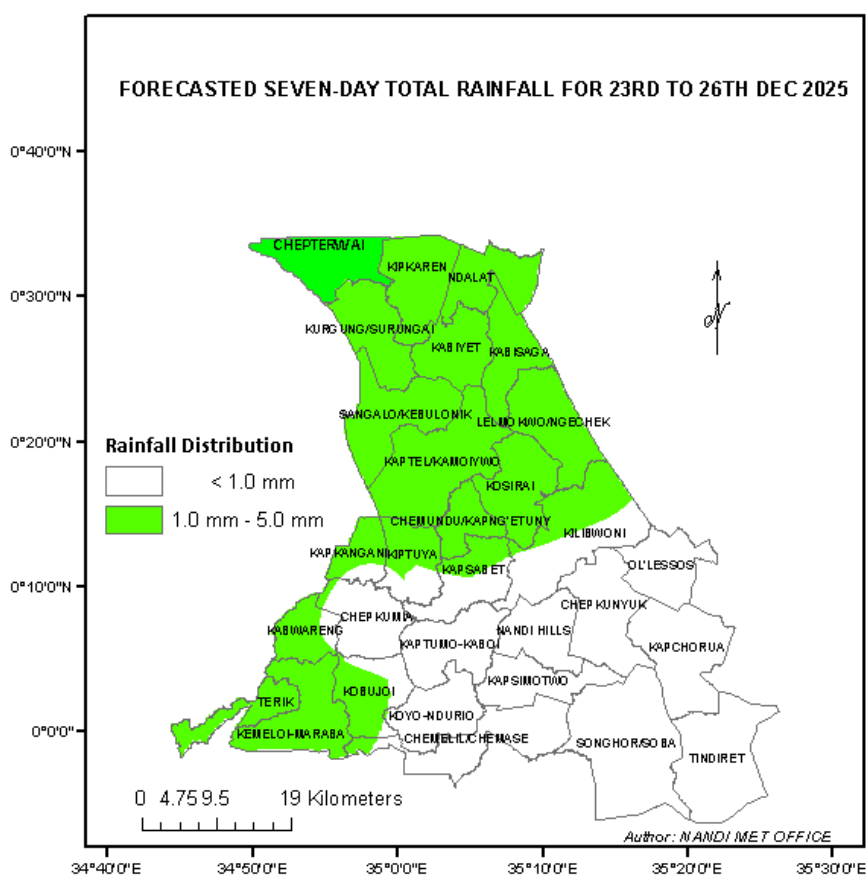


Figure 1: Forecasted Seven-Day total rainfall valid 23rd to 29th Dec 2025

Light to moderate rainfall covering few places is expected during the forecast period (fig 1 below). Temperature range is likely to be between 12°-28°C

Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- **Morning sessions:** Mainly sunny intervals to dominate during the forecast period.
- **Afternoon sessions** Few places in the county are likely to receive light to moderate rainfall during the forecast period. Light rainfall over few places is likely on Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday and Sunday. Moderate rainfall over few places is likely on Monday.
- **Nights:** Partly cloudy conditions are expected during the forecast period.
- Maximum temperature ranges likely to be 27-28°C whereas minimum temperatures range likely to be 12°- 15°C during the forecast period
