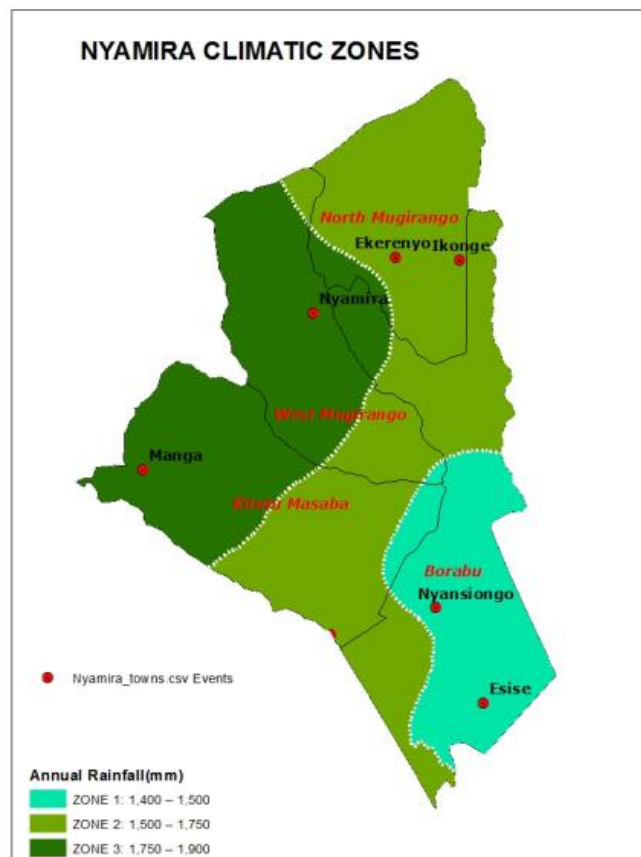
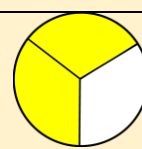


Figure 1: Nyamira climate zones

NYAMIRA WEEKLY WEATHER SUMMARY AND ADVISORIES

I. General Weather Outlook

The weather forecast for this week indicates that rainfall is expected to persist, although at levels lower than those recorded in the previous week.

Weather Pattern:

- **Rainfall Distribution:** Light to moderate precipitation is anticipated primarily during the morning hours. Specifically, Zones 1 and 2 can expect rainfall on Monday, while Zone 3 is projected to experience rain on Friday and again on Monday.
- **Afternoon/Evening Conditions:** The county will likely encounter showers accompanied by thunderstorms on Sunday and Monday for Zones 1 and 2, as well as on Tuesday, Sunday, and Monday in Zone 3.

II. Temperature Forecast

- **Maximum Daytime Temperature:** Expected to range between 20°C and 28°C.
- **Minimum Nighttime Temperature:** Anticipated to range between 11°C and 15°C.

III. Sector-Specific Advisories

- **Agricultural Advisory:** Farmers are strongly encouraged to consult with the Departments of Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries, and Cooperative Development. This collaboration will provide tailored guidance on optimal agricultural practices suited to the current climatic conditions, ensuring crop resilience and productivity.
- **Transportation Advisory:** Motorists and pedestrians are advised to exercise heightened caution while navigating roadways during rainy days. The potential for hazardous conditions necessitates vigilance to ensure safety.
- **Resident Advisory:** Residents are urged to avoid seeking shelter under trees during rainfall. This precaution is essential to minimize the risk of being struck by lightning or injured by falling branches, which can occur due to the occasional strong winds associated with rainstorms.

IV. Recommendations

All residents are urged to remain vigilant and adopt appropriate safety measures in response to the forecasted weather conditions.

By adhering to these recommendations and advisories, the community can better navigate the challenges posed by the current weather patterns while ensuring safety and preparedness.
