




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DAILY MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST FOR KENYAN COAST

Issued at: 1500 EAT on 31st December, 2025

Valid: 0000 EAT on 1st January, 2026 to 0000 EAT on 2nd January, 2026.



GENERAL OUTLOOK

Morning sea state:

- Light and variable predominantly N to NE winds (03-08knots) with smooth to slight choppy seas. ESE waves of 2ft (0.6m) with very small short to mid period waves of (9-10sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Afternoon sea state:

- Light to breezy NE to E winds (07-17knots) with slight to moderate choppy seas. E to ESE waves of 2-4ft (0.6-1.2m) with very small mid period to small very short period waves of (4-10sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Visibility:

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST

i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: N 4 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 2 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: NE 13 to 14 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 2 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy NE winds with moderate choppy seas. Very small mid period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:14AM** and sunset: **6:37PM**
- Visibility: Moderate (**9-10 km**)
- High Tide: **1:59AM;3.39m, 2:37PM;2.74m**
- Low Tide: **8:37AM;0.70m, 8:26PM;0.79m**

ii. MOMBASA

- Morning Winds: N 3 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 2 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 7 to 8 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 2 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light ENE winds with a slight chop. Very small mid period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:14AM** and sunset: **6:35PM**
- Visibility: Moderate (**9-10 km**)
- High Tide: **2:02AM;3.33m, 2:44PM;2.59m**
- Low Tide: **8:40AM;0.66m, 8:22PM;0.79m**

iii. KILIFI

- Morning Winds: ENE 6 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 2 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light ENE winds with a slight chop. Very small mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 9 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 3 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light E winds with a slight chop. Very small mid period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:15AM** and sunset: **6:34PM**
- Visibility: Moderate (**9-10km**)
- High Tide: **1:51AM;3.01m, 2:36PM;2.30m**
- Low Tide: **8:34AM;0.48m, 8:16PM;0.65m**

iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: NE 4 to 8 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 2 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 9 to 17 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: E 4 feet at 4 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light E winds with a slight chop. Small very short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:12AM** and Sunset: **6:27PM**
- Visibility: Moderate (**9-10km**)
- High Tide: **1:51AM;2.91m, 2:36PM;2.16m**
- Low Tide: **8:37AM;0.45m, 8:15PM;0.62m**

Advisory

- Slight to moderate sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 0.6-1.2m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light to fresh breeze of 03-17knots expected in Kwale, Mombasa Kilifi and Lamu throughout the forecast period.

4.1 – 5.5 m (\approx 12.3 – 16.5 ft)	Very Rough	Warning in place and marine activities on hold

KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 6 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – \geq 34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
