PART I: WEATHER OUTLOOK ACROSS THE COUNTRY

Sunny conditions expected over most parts of the country. Strong southeasterly winds of above 25 knots (12.5m/s) expected over parts of Turkana and Marsabit counties.

HIGHLANDS WEST OF THE RIFT VALLEY, THE LAKE VICTORIA BASIN, AND THE RIFT VALLEY

(These counties include: KAKAMEGA, VIHIGA, BUSIA, BUNGOMA, KISUMU, KISII, NYAMIRA, MIGORI, SIAYA, HOMABAY, KERICHO, NANDI, BOMET, NAKURU, ELGEYO MARAKWET, WEST POKOT, BARINGO, UASIN GISHU, TRANS-NZOIA, and NAROK).

Partly cloudy conditions with showers over few places expected tonight. Sunny interval expected to prevail the entire day tomorrow with a chance of showers expected over few places in the afternoon.

HIGHLANDS EAST OF THE RIFT VALLEY (INCLUDING NAIROBI COUNTY)

(These counties include: NYERI, MURANGA, KIRINYAGA, EMBU, MERU, KIAMBU, THARAKA NITHI, LAIKIPIA, NYANDARUA, and NAIROBI).

Partly cloudy conditions expected tonight. Sunny intervals expected in the morning. Mainly sunny intervals expected in the afternoon with a chance of light showers over few places.

NORTH WESTERN

(These counties include TURKANA and SAMBURU).

Partly cloudy conditions expected tonight. Sunny conditions expected to prevail the entire day tomorrow. Strong southeasterly winds of above 25 knots (12.5m/s) expected over Turkana County.

NORTH EASTERN

(These counties include MARSABIT, GARISSA, MANDERA, WAJIR, and ISIOLO).

Partly cloudy conditions expected tonight. Sunny conditions expected to prevail the entire day tomorrow. Strong southeasterly winds of above 25 knots (12.5m/s) expected over Marsabit county.

SOUTH EASTERN LOWLANDS

(These counties include: MACHAKOS, MAKUENI, KITUI, TAITA TAVETA, and KAJIADO).

Partly cloudy conditions expected tonight. Sunny conditions expected in the morning. Mainly sunny intervals expected in the afternoon with a chance of showers over few places (Mt. Kilimanjaro).

COAST

(These counties include: KWALE, MOMBASA, KILIFI, LAMU, and TANA RIVER).

Partly cloudy conditions expected tonight. Sunny intervals expected to prevail the entire day tomorrow.
