





**DAILY MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST FOR KENYAN COAST**

**GENERAL OUTLOOK**

**Morning sea state:**

- Light to gentle breezy NW to NNE winds (03-11knots) with smooth to moderate choppy seas. ENE to E waves of 4-5ft (1.2-1.5m) with small to moderate short period waves of (8sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

**Afternoon sea state:**

- Gentle to strong breezy ENE to E winds (11-23knots) with moderate to choppy seas. ENE to E waves of 4-5ft (1.2-1.5m) with small to moderate short period waves of (8sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

**Visibility:**

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

## **COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST**

### **i. KWALE**

- Morning Winds: NNW 8 to 9 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 5 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light NNW winds with a slight chop. Moderate short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 19 to 23 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 5 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong ENE winds with choppy seas. Moderate short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:24AM** and sunset: **6:44PM**
- Visibility: Moderate (**9-10 km**)
- High Tide: **7:55AM;2.9m, 8:34PM;3.1m**
- Low Tide: **1:57AM;0.8m, 2:06PM;0.7m**

### **ii. MOMBASA**

- Morning Winds: NW 5 to 6 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 4 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 13 to 18 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 4 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy ENE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:24AM** and sunset: **6:42PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: **8:04AM;2.9m, 8:38PM;3.1m**
- Low Tide: **1:58AM;0.8m, 2:06PM;0.6m**

### **iii. KILIFI**

- Morning Winds: NNE 10 to 11 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 5 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Breezy NNE winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 15 to 20 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 5 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy ENE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6.24AM** and sunset: **6:41PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **7:49AM;2.6m, 8:25PM;2.8m**
- Low Tide: **1:51AM;0.6m, 1:57PM;0.5m**

### **iv. LAMU**

- Morning Winds: NNE 3 knots.
- Morning Waves: E 5 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 11 to 18 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: E 5 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy E winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:21AM** and Sunset: **6:35PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **7:48AM;2.5m, 8:26PM;2.7m**
- Low Tide: **1:52AM;0.6m, 1:58PM;0.5m**

### **Advisory**

- Slight to moderate sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 1.2-1.5m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light to strong breeze of 03-23knots expected in Kwale, Mombasa Kilifi and Lamu throughout the forecast period. **Small boats and crafts are advised to be cautious while venturing into deep sea areas.**

### **KEY ON SEA STATE**

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 6 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
