





**DAILY MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST FOR KENYAN COAST**

**Issued at: 1500 EAT on 6<sup>th</sup> February, 2026**

**Valid: 0000 EAT on 7<sup>th</sup> February, 2026 to 0000 EAT on 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2026.**



**GENERAL OUTLOOK**

**Morning sea state:**

- Light to gentle breezy NW to ENE winds (03-08knots) with smooth to slight choppy seas. ENE to E waves of 3-4ft (0.9-1.2m) with small very short to small short period waves of (6-7sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

**Afternoon sea state:**

- Gentle to fresh breezy ENE to E winds (10-20knots) with moderate to choppy seas. ENE to E waves of 3-4ft (0.9-1.2m) with small short period waves of (7sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

**Visibility:**

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

## COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST

### i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: N 8 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 4 feet at 7 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light N winds with a slight chop. Small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 15 to 19 knots.
- Afternoon ENE 4 feet at 7 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong E winds with choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:29AM** and sunset: **6:45PM**
- Visibility: Moderate (**9-10 km**)
- High Tide: **7:17AM;3.16m, 7:39PM;3.21m**
- Low Tide: **1:11AM;0.57m, 1:21PM;0.58m**

### ii. MOMBASA

- Morning Winds: NW 4 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 3 feet at 7 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ENE 14 to 18 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 3 feet at 7 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy ENE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:27AM** and sunset: **6:43PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: **7:21AM;3.08m, 7:46PM;3.2m**
- Low Tide: **1:18AM;0.61m, 1:24PM;0.53m**

### iii. KILIFI

- Morning Winds: NE 5 to 6 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 4 feet at 7 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 15 to 20 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 4 feet at 7 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong E winds with choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:28AM** and sunset: **6:42PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **7:10AM;2.78m, 7:34PM;2.91m**
- Low Tide: **1:10AM;0.46m, 1:15PM;0.39m**

### iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: ENE 3 knots.
- Morning Waves: E 3 feet at 6 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Small very short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 10 to 17 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: E 3 feet at 7 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy E winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:24AM** and Sunset: **6:36PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **7:10AM;2.66m, 7:36PM;2.8m**
- Low Tide: **1:12AM;0.45m, 1:16PM;0.36m**

### Advisory

- Slight sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 0.9-1.2m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light to fresh breeze of 03-20knots expected in Kwale, Mombasa Kilifi and Lamu throughout the forecast period.

### KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 6 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
