WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST

Period of forecast: Tuesday February to Monday 9th February 2026

REF: KMD/BGM/WK/FCST/05-2026

Date of issue: Monday 2nd February 2026

Summary

This week's forecast indicates that:

- In the morning, most places are likely to experience sunny intervals.
- In the afternoon most places during the first half of the forecast period are likely to be generally dry. However, few places may experience light showers. In the second half of the forecast period, few to several places are likely to receive light to moderate showers.
- At night most places are likely to be partly cloudy.
- Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 26 and 29 degrees Celsius.
- Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 14 and 17 degrees Celsius.

The expected rainfall distribution for the next seven days from Tuesday 3rd February 2026 to Monday 9th February 2026 is shown in Figure 1.

Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  and rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Key to hazard colours:

Green	No severe weather is expected.
Amber	Severe weather conditions are likely to occur that may pose a threat to life and damage property. Be prepared.
Red	Dangerous and potentially life threatening weather conditions are expected. Take appropriate action immediately to ensure your safety and the safety of your family and neighbours.

Explanation of terminologies

Terminology	Meaning
Light rainfall	< 5 mm
Moderate rainfall	5 – 20 mm
Heavy rainfall	20 -50 mm
Very heavy rainfall	.>50 mm
Few places	Below 33% coverage
Several places	Between 33% and 67% coverage
Most places	Between 67% and 100% coverage

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- Consider implementing water conservation measures such as mulching.
- Use water sparingly.
- Harvest rain water whenever it rains.
- Users are advised that this is a forecast and at times there may be discrepancies between forecast estimates and actual amounts of rainfall received.
