THE OUTLOOK FOR FEBRUARY 2026 AND THE REVIEW OF JANUARY 2026, FOR TAITA
TAVETA COUNTY

1. HIGHLIGHTS

1.1 The Rainfall Outlook for February 2026

The county is expected to experience generally dry conditions for most of February. Occasional light rainfall may occur over a few isolated areas, but rainfall amounts are likely to be low and sporadic. Overall rainfall is expected to be below normal for this time of year. Daytime temperatures are expected to range between 24°C and 36°C, with hotter conditions over the low-lying areas. Night-time temperatures are likely to range between 12°C and 23°C. Temperatures are expected to be warmer than average, increasing the risk of heat stress.

1.2 Outlook for February to April 2026

The outlook for the next three months indicates that sunny and dry weather conditions are expected to dominate most parts of the county. However, a few areas may experience occasional light rain days during the forecast period. Temperatures are expected to be warmer than average across most parts of the county. March is expected to mark the onset of the rainfall season over several parts of the county, while April is anticipated to represent the peak of the season, with more widespread and enhanced rainfall distribution. Temperatures are expected to be warmer than average over the whole county during the forecast period.

1.3 The Review for January 2026

Sunny and dry conditions prevailed over most parts of the county during the month, with a few days of light rains in isolated areas. This rainfall was below the January Long Term Mean.

2. RAINFALL FORECAST FOR FEBRUARY 2026

The forecast indicates that mainly sunny and dry conditions are expected to prevail over most parts of the county for much of the month. However, occasional rainfall is likely in a few areas. Figure 1 illustrates the expected rainfall pattern for February 2026.
