Commentary of Weekly Weather forecast valid from 10th to 16th February 2026.

Generally, the County is likely to experience sunny and dry weather conditions over several places. However, few places may experience light shows and partly cloudy conditions especially in the highlands.

Detailed Forecasts:

Mornings are likely to experience sunny intervals and little chance of morning rains in the upper highlands of Pokot South and Kapenguria environs. Afternoons may experience partly cloudy and light rains over few places. Nights may experience partly cloudy and light night rains but over few places. Temperatures are anticipated to be warmer than normal. Daytime temperatures in the range of 23^oc to 37^oc and nights in the range of 06^oc to 20^oc.

Weather Review as from 03rd to 09th February 2026:

Dry and sunny weather conditions were experience over several places. However, light showers were experienced over few places during the last half of the week in Siyoi , Kapenuria, Nasukuta, Alale girls, St. Catherine girls and Lelan environs. Several stations recorded below 7.0mm rainfall during the week under review. There was a general decreased of daytime temperatures over most places.
