LAIKIPIA COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST VALID 10 – 16 FEBRUARY, 2026

SUMMARY

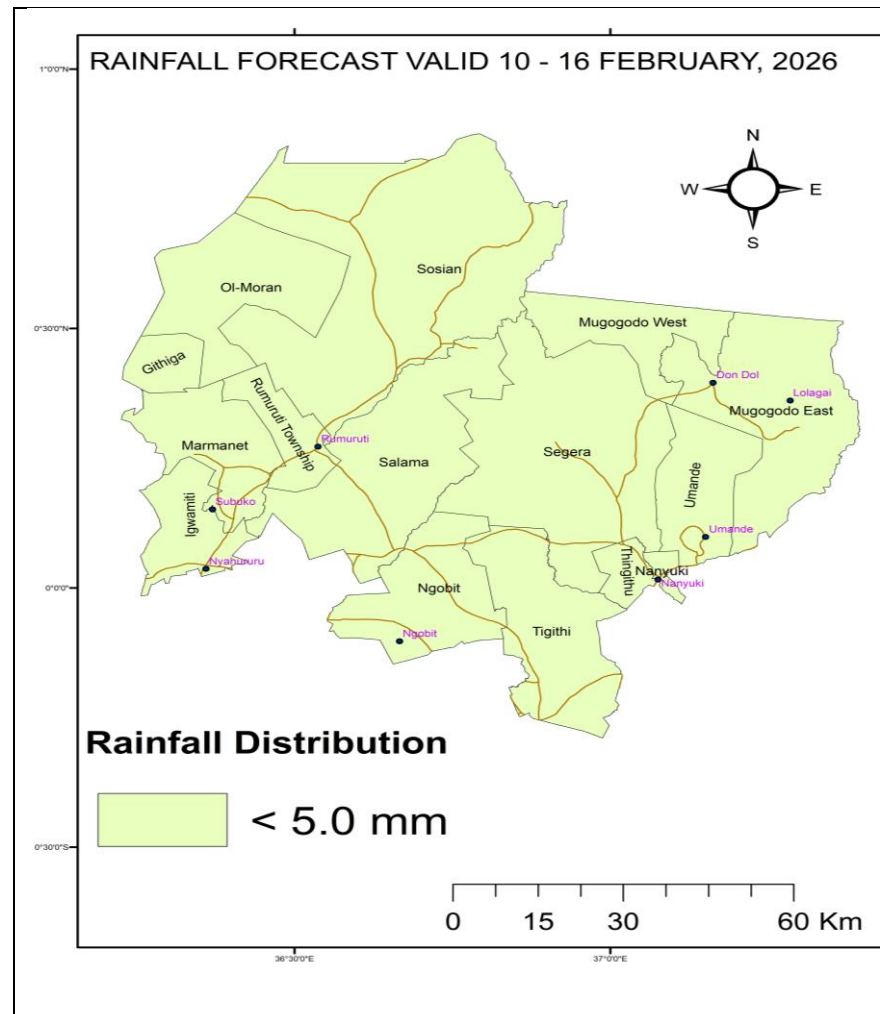
Weather Forecast for 10 - 16 February, 2026) indicates;

- Mainly dry and sunny conditions are expected over most places
- However, occasional light showers are likely over Few Places in Laikipia West and parts of Laikipia West
- The Maximum day time temperatures are expected to range between 24 – 30°C and the (Minimum night time temperatures are likely to range 05 - 16°C.
- Minimum Temperatures below 10.0°C are predicted around Nyahururu and the regions adjacent to Mt Kenya
- Advisory on **sudden** increases in the wind speeds >25 knots (gusting winds speeds) that may lead to the risks of dust storms, breaking of tress/branches, blowing the house roofs etc

Weather review for 03 – 09 February, 2026

- Stations that recorded light to moderate amounts of rainfall includes Lamuria, Three Rivers, Thome, Lokusero and a few other areas
- *Comparing the last two weeks the precipitation amounts decreased over a most places*
- The day time maximum temperatures and the night time minimum temperatures varied from place to place

Expected Rainfall Distribution for the Next Seven Days 10 – 16 February, 2026)



Mainly sunny conditions expected over most places

Less than 5.0 mm of the cumulated weekly rainfall is predicted as indicated on the adjacent rainfall forecast map

Day time Maximum temperatures are likely to increase over most places.

Much of the predicted rains are likely in the second half of the forecasting period, mainly on Saturday

RAINFALL CATEGORIES		RAINFALL COVERAGE	
< 5 mm	Light	TERMs	MEANING
5 – 20 mm	Moderate	Most places	Between 67% and 100%
20 – 50 mm	Heavy	Several Places	Between 33% and 67%
> 50 mm	Very heavy	Few places	Below 33%
