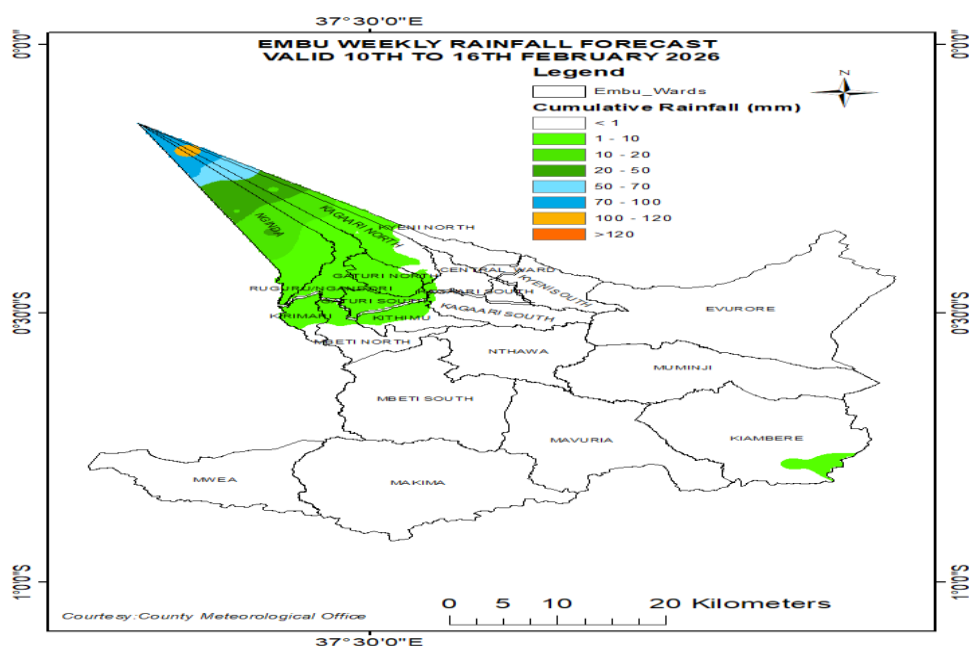

Weather forecast 10-16 Feb 2026

- Generally dry conditions expected with sunny to sunny intervals.
- Occasional light rains expected over few places (high grounds) in Manyatta and Runyenjes Sub-Counties towards the end of the forecast period.
- Clear to partly cloudy nights expected in most of the forecast period.
