SEVEN-DAY WEATHER FORECAST VALID 3RD TO 9TH FEBRUARY 2026

HIGHLIGHTS

Forecast for 10th to 16th February 2026

- *Several parts of the county are expected to be sunny. However, rainfall is likely to occur to the central and eastern sector of the county during the forecast period.*

Weather Review 2nd to 8th February 2026

- *There was an increase in rainfall activities over the County during the review period.*
- *Ulanda AWS in Awendo Sub County recorded the highest weekly cumulative rainfall amount of 61.0mm.*

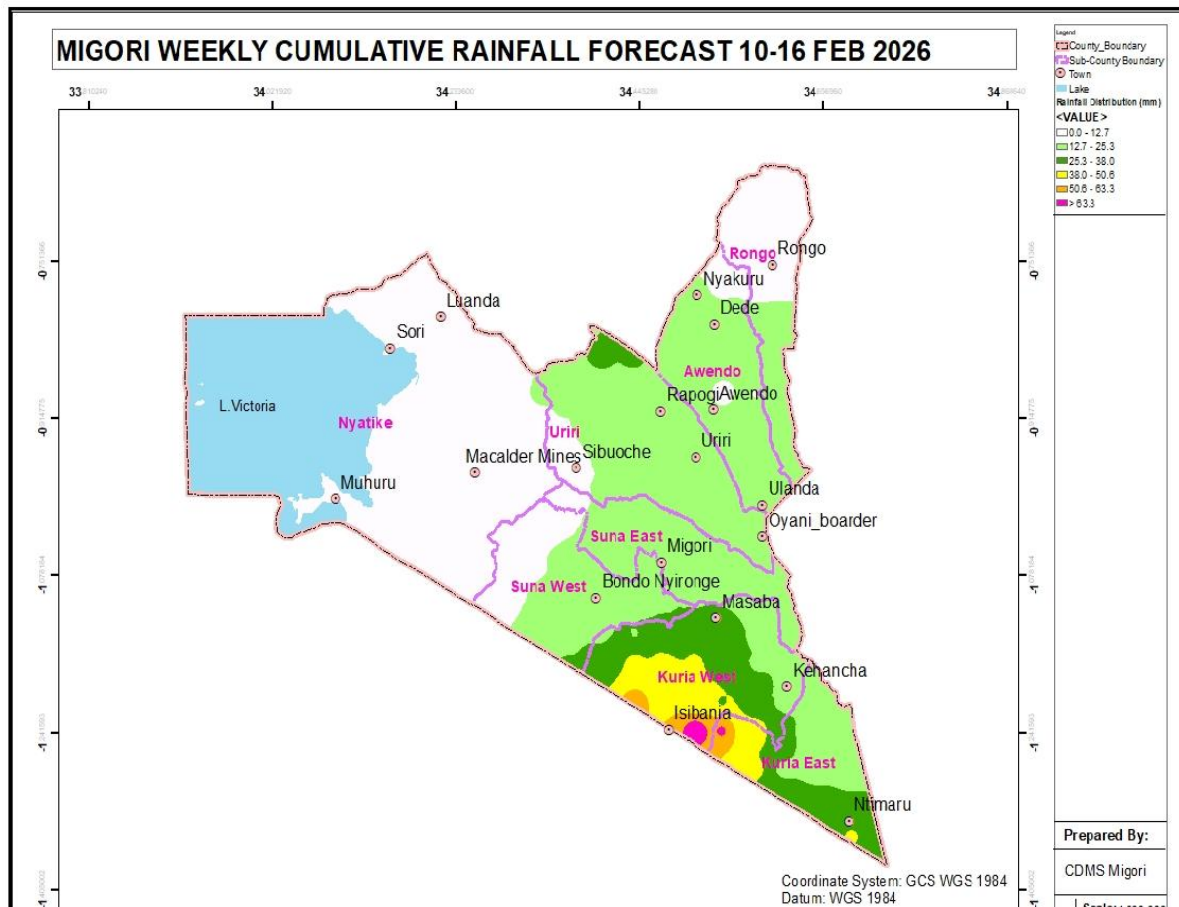


Figure 1: 7day cumulative rainfall forecast valid 10th to 16th February 2026

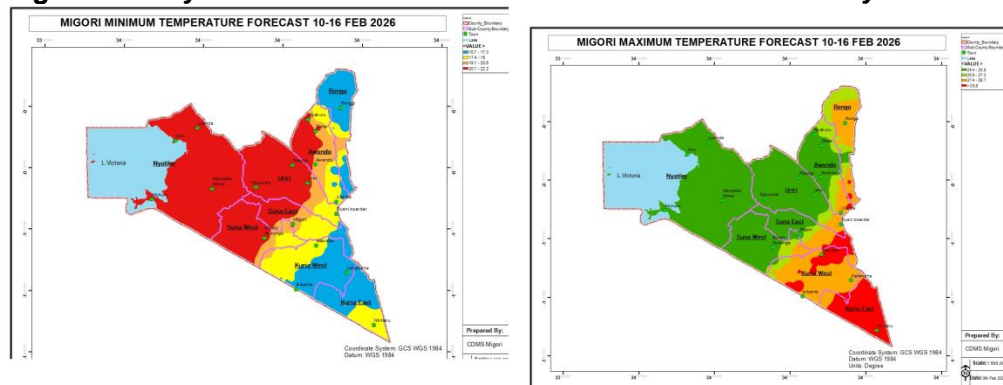


Figure 2: Minimum and Maximum Temperature Forecast 10th to 16th February 2026

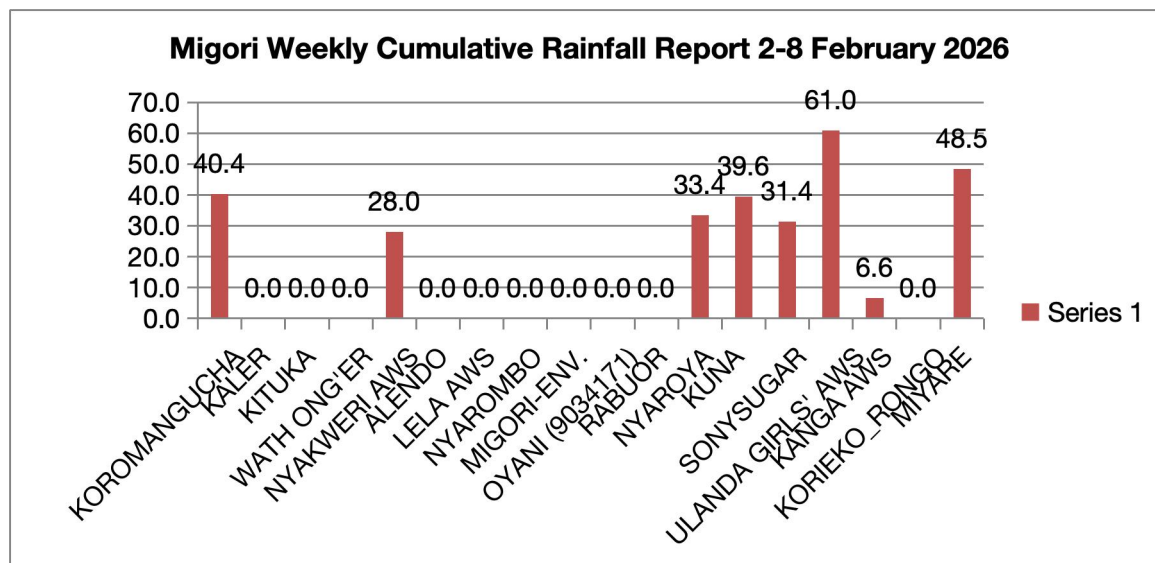

Detailed forecast the regions in table 1 and 2

- *Morning rains are likely to occur over few places. Afternoon showers and thunderstorms are expected over few places during the first half of the forecast period increasing to several places thereafter. Night showers are likely to occur over few places.*

Weather Review for 2nd to 8th February 2026



- There was an increase in rainfall activities over the county during the review period.
- Ulanda AWS in Awendo Sub County recorded the highest weekly cumulative rainfall amount of 61.0mm and also recording the highest rainfall within 24-hour period of 31.9mm on 5th February 2026. Other stations that recorded significant rainfall are Miyare (48.5mm); Koromangucha (40.4mm); Kuna (39.6mm); Nyaroya (33.4mm); Lower Kuja Irrigation Scheme- Nyakweri AWS (18.0mm); Sony Sugar (31.4mm); Nyakweri (28.0mm) while the rest of the stations recorded less than 10mm of rain.
