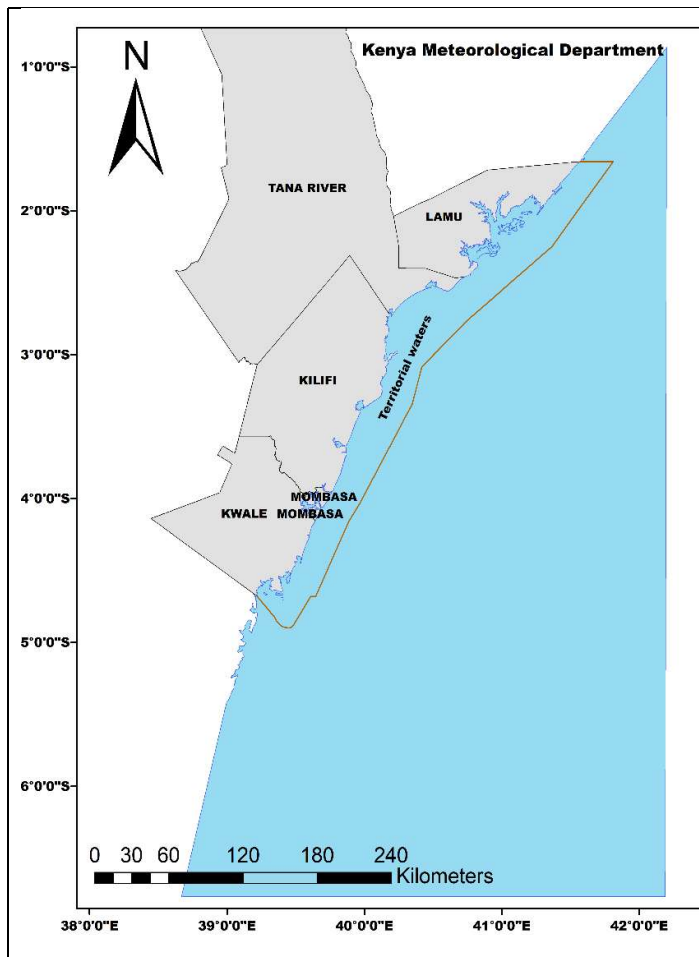

Issued at: 1500 EAT on 11th February, 2026
Valid: 0000 EAT on 12th February, 2026 to 0000 EAT on 13th February, 2026.



GENERAL OUTLOOK

Morning sea state:

- Calm to gentle breezy W to NE winds (00-09knots) with smooth to slight choppy seas. NE to E waves of 3-4ft (0.9-1.2m) with small very short period waves of (5-6sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Afternoon sea state:

- Gentle to fresh breezy ENE to E winds (10-21knots) with moderate to choppy seas. ENE to E waves of 3-4ft (0.9-1.2m) with small very short to small short period waves of (4-7sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Visibility:

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST

i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: NNW 9 knots.
- Morning Waves: NE 3 feet at 6 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light NNW winds with a slight chop. Small very short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 18 to 21 knots.
- Afternoon NE 4 feet at 6 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong E winds with choppy seas. Small very short period waves
- Sunrise: **6:29AM** and sunset: **6:44PM**
- Visibility: Moderate (**9-10 km**)
- High Tide: **00:04AM;2.51m; 1:25PM;2.01m**
- Low Tide: **7:46AM;1.52m, 6:44PM;1.6m**

ii. MOMBASA

- Morning Winds: N 4 to 5 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 3 feet at 6 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Small very short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 16 to 18 knots.
- Afternoon ENE 3 feet at 7 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong E winds with choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:28AM** and sunset: **6:42PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: **1:20PM;1.92m**
- Low Tide: **7:19AM;1.53m, 6:33PM;1.58m**

iii. KILIFI

- Morning Winds: NE 5 to 6 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 4 feet at 6 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light NE winds with a slight chop. Small very short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 18 to 19 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 4 feet at 7 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong E winds with choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:28AM** and sunset: **6:42PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **1:48PM;1.66m**
- Low Tide: **7:40AM;1.27m, 6:39PM;1.39m**

iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: W 0 to 1 knots.
- Morning Waves: E 3 feet at 5 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Small very short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 10 to 17 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: E 3 feet at 4 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy E winds with moderate choppy seas. Small very short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:24AM** and Sunset: **6:36PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **1:49PM;1.56m**
- Low Tide: **7:45AM;1.2m, 6:36PM;1.33m**

Advisory

- Slight to moderate sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 0.9-1.2m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Calm to fresh breeze of 00-21knots expected in Kwale, Mombasa Kilifi and Lamu throughout the forecast period. **Small boats and crafts are advised to be cautious while carrying out marine activities.**

2.0 – 2.9 m (≈ 6.0 – 8.7 ft)	Moderate-Rough	Caution on operating marine activities
3.0 – 4.0 m (≈ 9.0 – 12.0 ft)	Rough	Warning in place!!!!
4.1 – 5.5 m (≈ 12.3 – 16.5 ft)	Very Rough	Warning in place and marine activities on hold

KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 6 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
