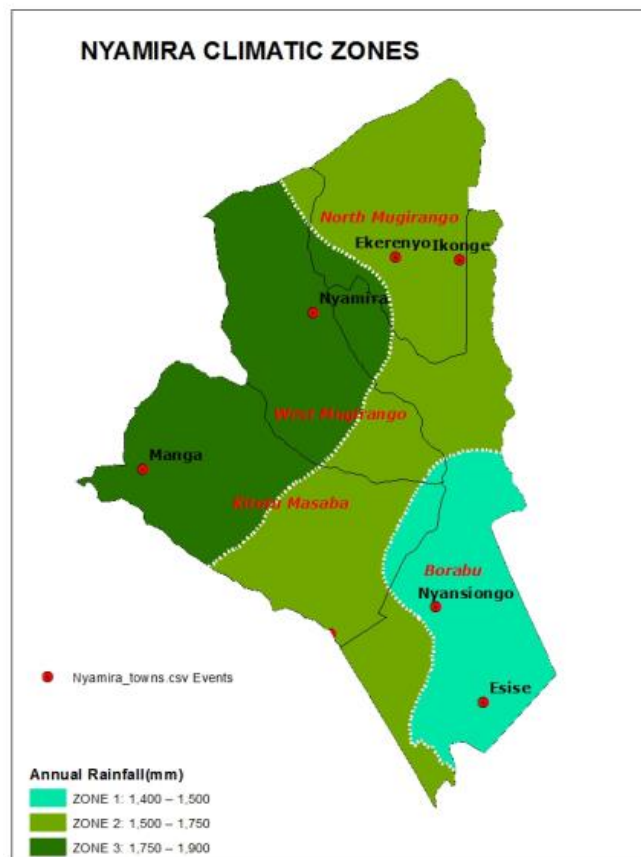
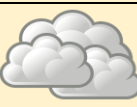
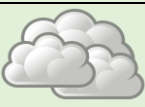
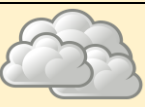


Figure 1: Nyamira climate zones

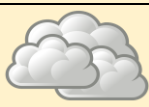

NYAMIRA COUNTY: WEEKLY WEATHER OUTLOOK AND MULTI-SECTORAL ADVISORY

I. Precipitation Summary

- **Forecast:** Nyamira County expects **consistent wet weather** throughout the week.
- **Coverage & Timing:** There is a very high probability of rain across **Zones 1, 2, and 3** for the entire duration of the week.
- **Morning Conditions:** Expect light to moderate rainfall during the early hours, with the most frequent activity occurring on **Tuesday, Thursday, Sunday, and Monday**.

II. Temperature Profile

- **Daytime Highs:** Maximum temperatures will fluctuate between **20°C and 26°C**.
- **Nighttime Lows:** Minimum temperatures are projected to drop to between **11°C and 15°C**.

III. Sectoral Advisories & Safety Measures

- **Agriculture:** Farmers and stakeholders are advised to consult the Nyamira County Department of Agriculture for expert guidance on crop and livestock management during this rainy period.
- **Lightning & Public Safety:** To avoid lightning strikes and falling trees, **do not seek shelter under tall trees** or open structures during storms.
- **Transportation:** Motorists & pedestrians should exercise extreme caution due to slippery roads and poor visibility as they use the roads to avoid accidents.
- **Child Safety:** Parents and guardians must ensure children **stay indoors** during thunderstorms to prevent lightning-related accidents.
- **Landslide Risk:** Residents in landslide-prone areas should remain alert. **Evacuate immediately** to safer ground if you notice cracks in the soil or sudden shifts in the terrain.

- **Infrastructure (County Government):** The County Government is urged to **clear all drainage systems immediately** to prevent flash flooding and waterlogging in urban centers.
- **Public Health (Ministry of Health):** The Ministry should ensure an adequate supply of essential medicines to manage potential outbreaks of waterborne and vector-borne diseases—such as **malaria, typhoid, cholera, and respiratory infections**—which often increase during the long rains.
- **Energy & Utilities:** To prevent power outages and safety hazards, the energy sector is advised to **trim or remove tree branches** hanging near overhead power lines.
- **Quarry Operations:** Workers are strictly cautioned **not to seek shelter inside or under quarry caves** during rainfall, as the saturated soil significantly increases the risk of cave-ins and fatal accidents.
