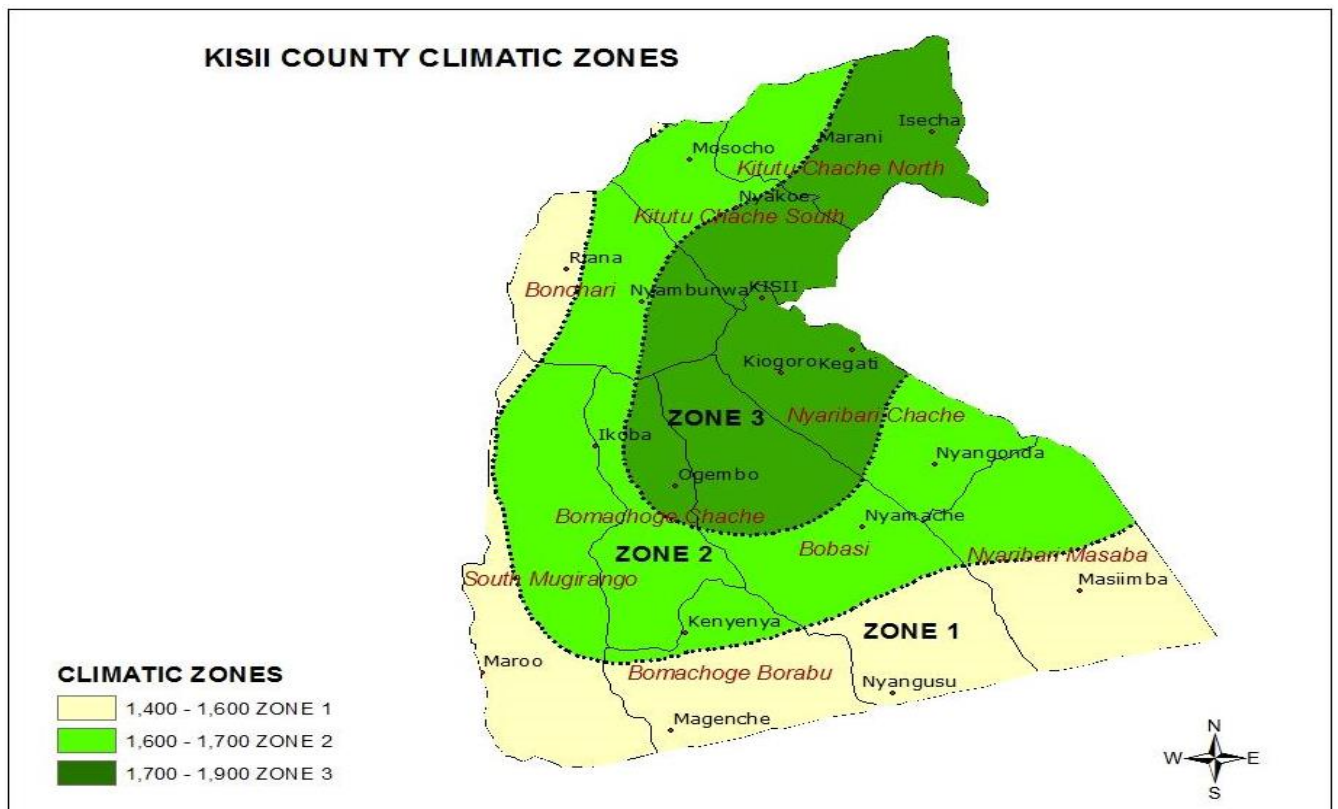
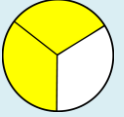
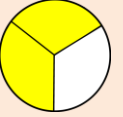
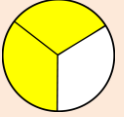
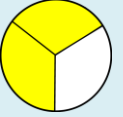


Figure 1: Kisii climatic zones

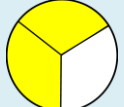

KISII COUNTY: WEEKLY WEATHER OUTLOOK AND ADVISORY

1. Meteorological Forecast

- **Precipitation:** Showers accompanied with thunderstorms expected in the afternoon/evening throughout this week in Kisii County.
- **Early Day precipitation:** Light to moderate precipitation is projected during morning hours, with high probability on Tuesday, Wednesday, Sunday and Monday

2. Thermal Conditions

- **Diurnal/daytime Maximums:** Daytime air temperatures are forecast to fluctuate between 20°C and 29°C.
- **Nocturnal/night Minimums:** Nighttime values are expected to stabilize within a range of 11°C to 17°C.

3. Sectoral Impact Advisories

- **Energy & Utilities:** To prevent power outages and safety hazards, the energy sector is advised to **trim or remove tree branches** hanging near overhead power lines.
- **Quarry Operations:** Workers are strictly cautioned **not to seek shelter inside or under quarry caves** during rainfall, as the saturated soil significantly increases the risk of cave-ins and fatal accidents.
- **Agro-meteorology:** Stakeholders are urged to coordinate with the Departments of **Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries, and Co-operative Development** to align their farming and livestock management strategies with the current weather patterns.
- **Road Safety & Infrastructure:** Unpaved and poorly maintained earthen roads across the County are expected to become **slippery and hazardous**. Motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians are urged to exercise extreme caution to prevent transit-related accidents.
- **Severe Weather Hazards:** Residents should prepare for occasional **strong winds, hailstorms, and intense thunderstorms** accompanying the seasonal rains.

- **Urban Drainage Management:** The County Government is advised to **expedite the clearing of drainage systems** to mitigate the risk of flash flooding in urban areas.
- **Public Health Preparedness:** The Ministry of Health should ensure health facilities are well-stocked with essential medicines to manage potential outbreaks of **malaria, typhoid, diarrhea, and respiratory infections** typically associated with the long rains.
- **Landslide Risk:** Residents in high-risk areas are advised to maintain constant vigilance. Should you observe ground tremors, widening soil cracks, or sudden shifts in terrain, **evacuate to higher ground immediately.**
