Summary

- The above figure shows the weekly cumulative volume of rainfall amounts each ward and/or sub-county in Nyandarua County is forecasted to receive from Tuesday 17th to Monday 23rd February 2026.
- Detailed forecast in the above climatic zone tables indicates that Kinangop sub county will receive the highest cumulative weekly rainfall of more than 70mm. Areas to the south are projected to receive cumulative weekly rainfall of more than 120mm. Parts of Kipipiri and Ndarangwa will receive cumulative weekly rainfall of between 20 and 50mm.
- Much of the county will, however, receive cumulative weekly rainfall of less than 20mm (refer to the map legend for details).
