WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST

Period of forecast: Tuesday 17th February to Monday 23rd February 2026

Date of issue: Monday 16th February 2026

Summary

This week's forecast indicates that:

- In the morning, most places are likely to experience sunny intervals. However, few places may receive light rain.
- In the afternoon few to several places are likely to receive light to moderate rainfall during the forecast period.
- At night most places are likely to be partly cloudy. However, few places may receive light rain.
- Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 25 and 27 degrees Celsius.
- Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 15 and 16 degrees Celsius.

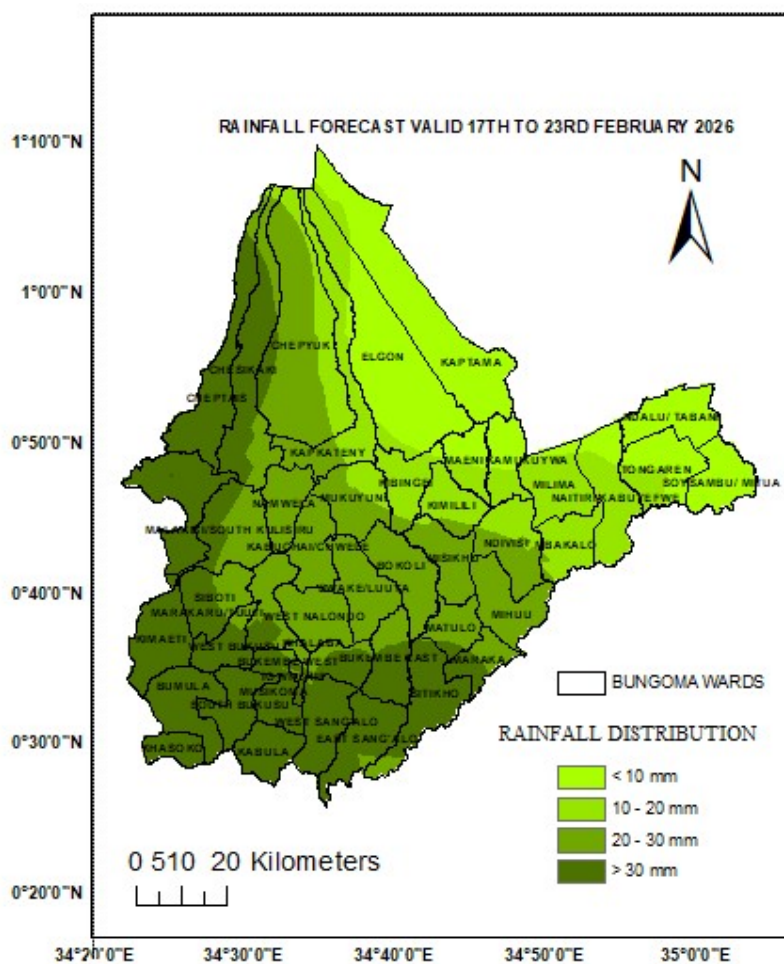


Figure 1: Expected Rainfall Distribution 17th – 23rd Feb February 2026

The expected rainfall distribution for the next seven days from Tuesday 17th February 2026 to Monday 23rd February 2026 is shown in Figure 1.

Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  and rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Key to hazard colours:

Green	No severe weather is expected.
Amber	Severe weather conditions are likely to occur that may pose a threat to life and damage property. Be prepared.
Red	Dangerous and potentially life threatening weather conditions are expected. Take appropriate action immediately to ensure your safety and the safety of your family and neighbours.

Explanation of terminologies

Terminology	Meaning
Light rainfall	< 5 mm
Moderate rainfall	5 – 20 mm
Heavy rainfall	20 -50 mm
Very heavy rainfall	.>50 mm
Few places	Below 33% coverage
Several places	Between 33% and 67% coverage
Most places	Between 67% and 100% coverage

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- Harvest rain water whenever it rains.
- Take advantage of the rainfall and plant a variety of food crops and trees as the rainfall is likely to lead to improved soil moisture.
- The expected rains may lead to destruction of infrastructure such as roads.
- Do not walk in the open or seek shelter under trees when it is raining in order to reduce the risk of being struck by lightning.
- The expected rains is likely to lead to regeneration of pastures and improved water availability for the livestock.
- Users are advised that this is a forecast and at times there may be discrepancies between forecast estimates and actual amounts of rainfall received.

Advice to farmers from Ministry of Agriculture:

- Consult your agricultural extension officer for advice in line with this forecast.
