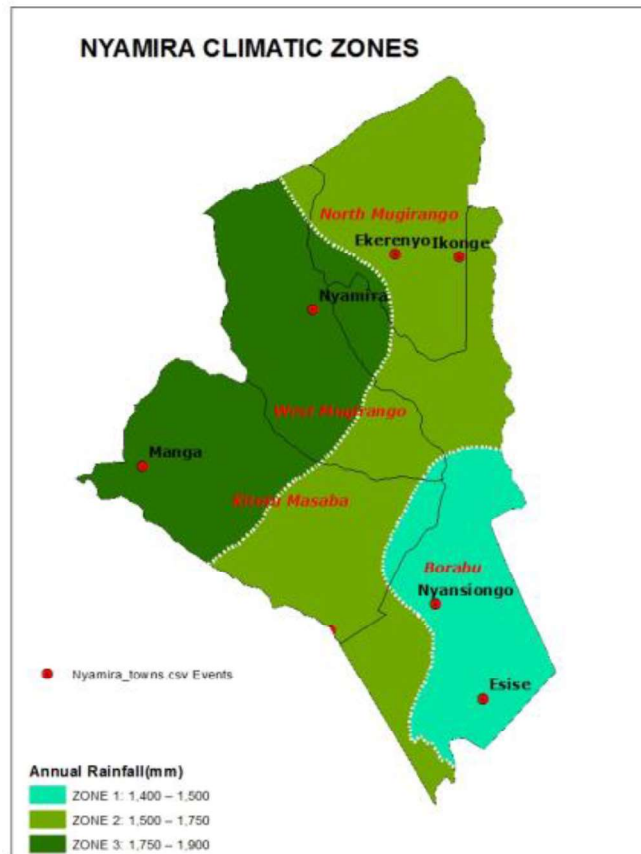


Figure 1: Nyamira climate zones

NYAMIRA COUNTY: WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST AND ADVISORY

I. Forecast Summary

Showers accompanied by thunderstorms are expected over several parts of Nyamira County, particularly during the afternoon and evening hours. In **Zone 1**, these conditions are anticipated on **Friday and Saturday**, while **Zones 2 and 3** are likely to experience similar weather on **Friday, Saturday, and Sunday**. Additionally, **Zone 3** is expected to receive afternoon and evening showers and thunderstorms on **Monday**.

Across all three zones, **light to moderate rainfall is likely during the morning hours**, with the highest likelihood occurring on **Friday**.

II. Temperature Outlook

- **Maximum Temperatures:** Daytime temperatures are forecast to range between **20°C and 30°C**.
- **Minimum Temperatures:** Nighttime temperatures are expected to range from **12°C to 17°C**.

III. Sector-Specific Advisories

- **Farmers** are advised to liaise with the **Departments of Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries, and Co-operative Development** for guidance on appropriate farming activities during the forecast period.
- **Residents** are strongly advised to avoid sheltering under trees during rainfall to reduce the risk of injuries from falling branches and lightning strikes.
- **Motorists and pedestrians** should exercise increased caution on roads due to reduced visibility and slippery conditions during rainy periods.
- **Parents and guardians** are advised to ensure that children do not play in open fields or exposed areas during thunderstorms, owing to the heightened risk of lightning strikes.
