LAIKIPIA COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST VALID 03 – 09 MARCH, 2026

SUMMARY

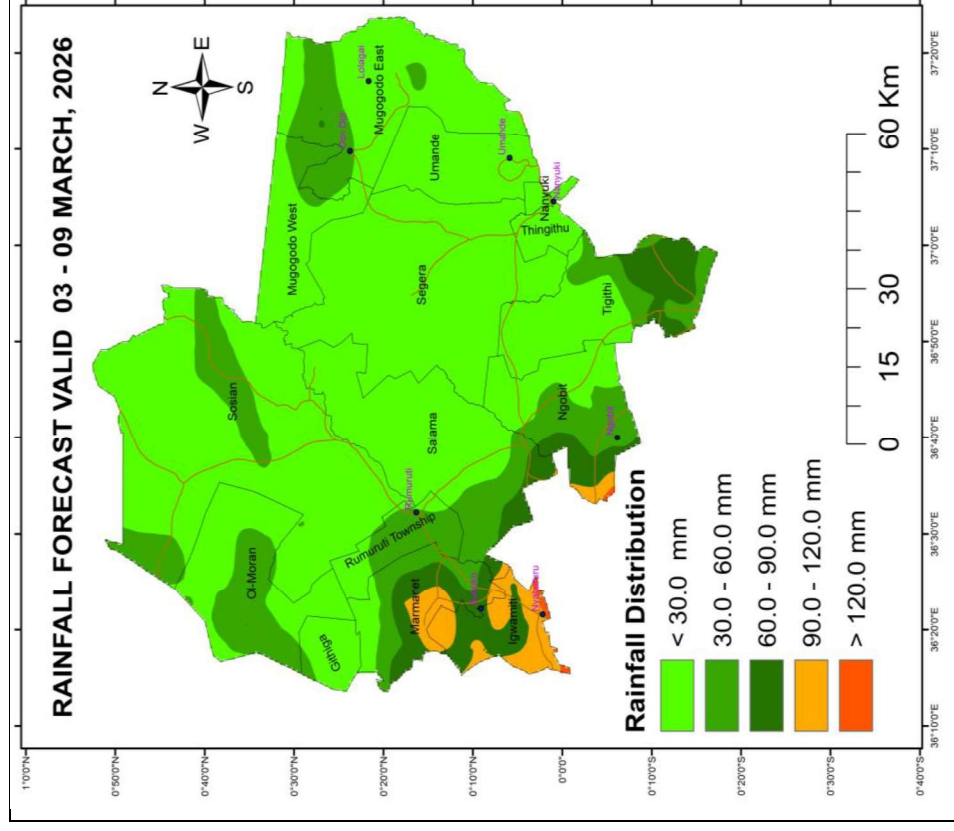
Weather Forecast for 03 - 09 March, 2026 indicates;

- Rainfall expected to continue over most places
- Light to moderate showers & thunderstorms are likely over Several Places
- Early morning rains followed by afternoon showers and thunderstorms, sometimes extending to the night are likely over several places especially in the first half of the forecasting period
- The Maximum day time temperatures are expected to range between 22 – 28°C and the (Minimum night time temperatures are likely to range 05 - 16°C.
- Minimum Temperatures below 10.0°C are predicted around Nyahururu and the regions adjacent to Mt Kenya

Weather review for 24 February – 02 March, 2026

- Nearly all Stations recorded light to heavy amounts of rainfall including DolDol, Borana, Ol Pejeta, Nanyuki, Sipili, Ol Mysor, Mugie, Lokusero, Ol Jogi and several other areas
- Comparing the last two weeks the precipitation amounts increased over a most places
- The day time maximum temperatures and the night time minimum temperatures varied from place to place

Expected Rainfall Distribution for the Next Seven Days (03 - 09 March, 2026)



Between **30 - 120 mm** of the cumulated weekly rainfall is predicted as indicated on the adjacent rainfall forecast map

Day time Maximum temperatures are likely to decrease especially in days with increased clouds and precipitation

NB; Be aware of the increased risk to sudden stormy rainfall and flash floods in isolated riverine areas
