

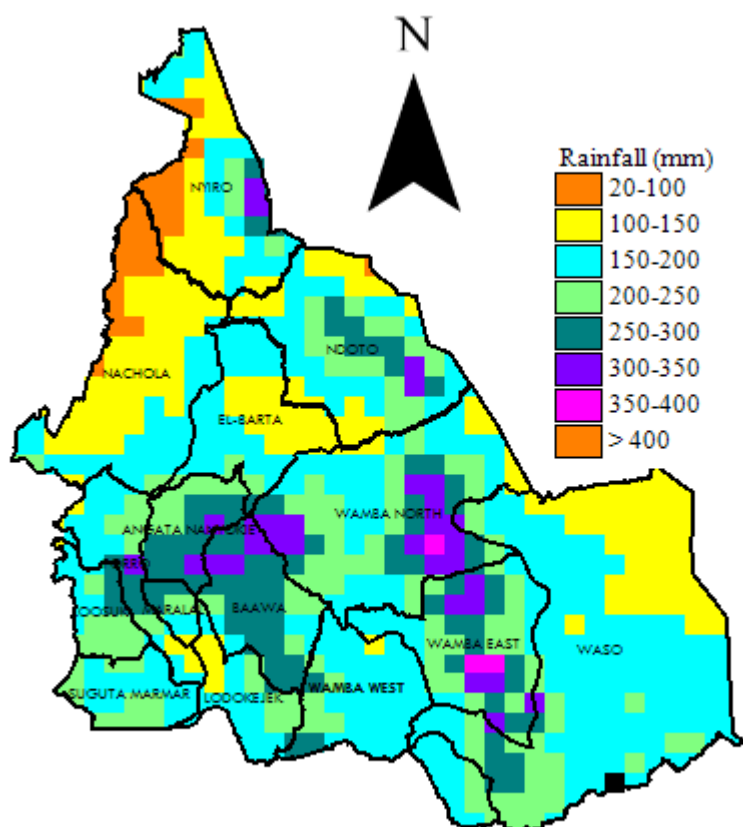

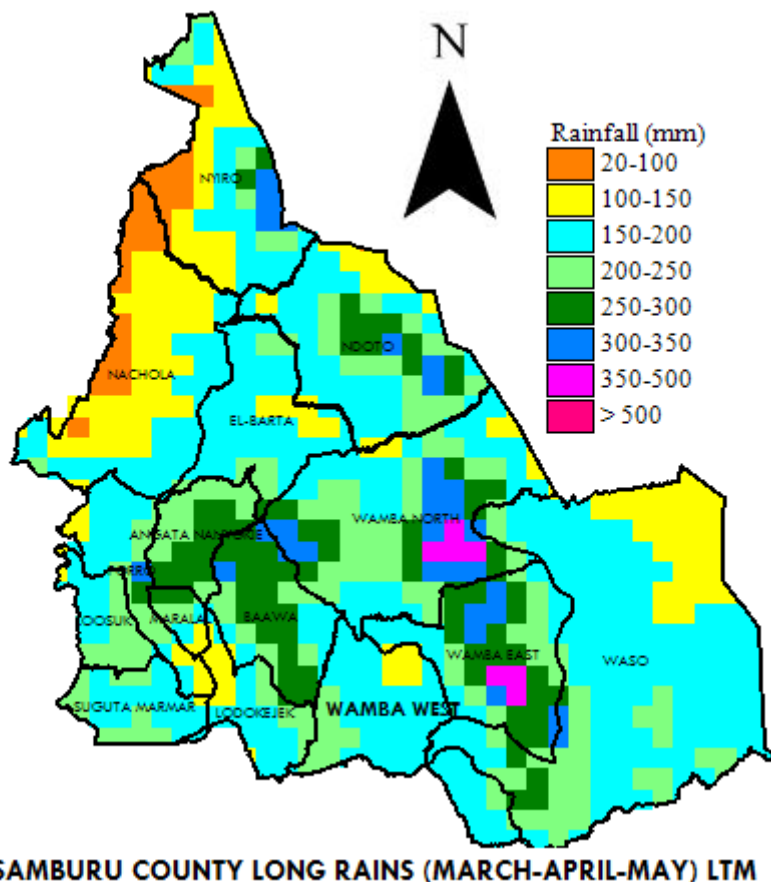
***March-April-May (MAM) 2026 Seasonal Rainfall Forecast***

Samburu county is likely to receive Near-Average to Above -Average Rainfall During March-April-May Rainfall season .The rains will continue from February and will be enhanced during first half of march with dry spells during the second half of the month when the madden -Julian oscillation (Mjo) is predicted to be in unfavorable phase .The cessation is predicted to be third to fourth week of May. The map (Fig .1) below shows the amount of rainfall in mm that is forecasted in each part of Samburu County .

### RECOMENTATIONS
