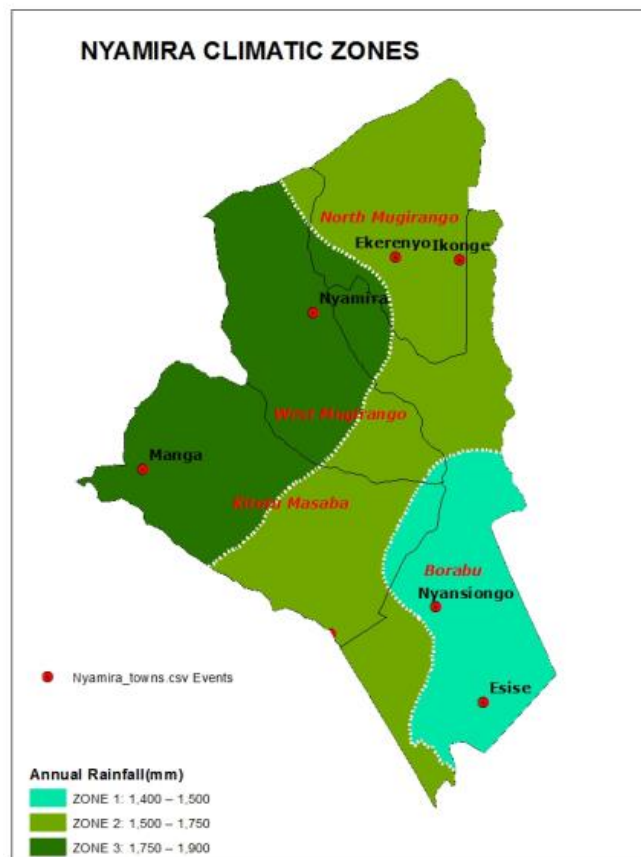
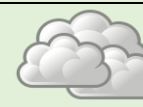
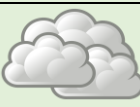
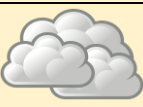
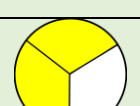
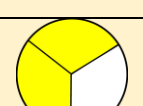
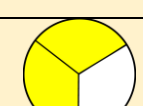
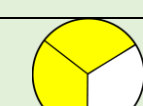


Figure 1: Nyamira climate zones

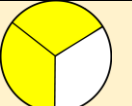

NYAMIRA COUNTY: WEEKLY WEATHER OUTLOOK & ADVISORY

I. Precipitation Forecast

- **Morning Conditions:** Light to moderate rainfall is expected during the early morning, particularly on **Friday and Saturday**.
- **Afternoon & Evening:** Showers and **thunderstorms** are likely to develop across several areas each afternoon and evening.

II. Temperature Outlook

- **Daytime Highs:** Maximum temperatures will range between **21°C and 27°C**.
- **Nighttime Lows:** Minimum temperatures will drop to between **11°C and 15°C**, leading to cool or chilly nights.

III. Sectoral Advisories & Safety Measures

- **Agriculture:** Farmers and stakeholders are encouraged to consult the **Department of Agriculture** for expert guidance on crop, livestock, and fisheries management during this rainy period.
- **Water Harvesting:** Residents are advised to **collect and store rainwater** to ensure adequate supply during future dry spells.
- **Lightning Safety:** To minimize the risk of lightning strikes, avoid sheltering under trees or standing in open fields. Parents should ensure **children remain indoors** during storms.
- **Transport & Road Safety:** Motorists and pedestrians are urged to exercise caution as rain may result in **slippery roads** and poor visibility.
- **Quarry Safety:** Quarry workers must not seek shelter within or beneath caves during rainfall. **Saturated soils** pose a high risk of life-threatening cave-ins.
- **Infrastructure & Drainage:** County authorities are urged to **clear drainage systems** immediately to mitigate the risk of flash flooding, especially in urban centers.
- **Public Health:** The Ministry of Health is advised to **pre-position essential medical supplies** to manage potential surges in malaria, typhoid, cholera, and respiratory infections
