WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST

Period of forecast: Tuesday 10th March to Monday 16th March 2026

REF: KMD/BGM/WK/FCST/10-2026

Date of issue: Monday 9th March 2026

Summary

This week's forecast indicates that:

- In the morning, most places are likely to experience sunny intervals. However, few places may be cloudy.
- In the afternoon several places are likely to receive moderate to light rainfall during the forecast period. However the intensity of the rain is likely to reduce towards the end of the forecast period.
- At night most places are likely to be partly cloudy. However, few places may receive light rain.
- Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 24 and 26 degrees Celsius.
- Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 14 and 16 degrees Celsius.

The expected rainfall distribution for the next seven days from Tuesday 10th March 2026 to Monday 16th March 2026 is shown in Figure 1.

Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  and rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Key to hazard colours:

Green	No severe weather is expected.
Amber	Severe weather conditions are likely to occur that may pose a threat to life and damage property. Be prepared.
Red	Dangerous and potentially life threatening weather conditions are expected. Take appropriate action immediately to ensure your safety and the safety of your family and neighbours.

Explanation of terminologies

Terminology	Meaning
Light rainfall	< 5 mm
Moderate rainfall	5 – 20 mm
Heavy rainfall	20 -50 mm
Very heavy rainfall	.>50 mm
Few places	Below 33% coverage
Several places	Between 33% and 67% coverage
Most places	Between 67% and 100% coverage

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- Harvest rain water whenever it rains.
- Do not walk in the open or seek shelter under trees when it is raining in order to reduce the risk of being struck by lightning.
- The expected rain is likely to lead to regeneration of pastures and improved water availability for the livestock.
- Users are advised that this is a forecast and at times there may be discrepancies between forecast estimates and actual amounts of rainfall received.

- Consult your agricultural extension officer for advice in line with this forecast.
