SIAYA COUNTY CLIMATOLOGICAL MAP

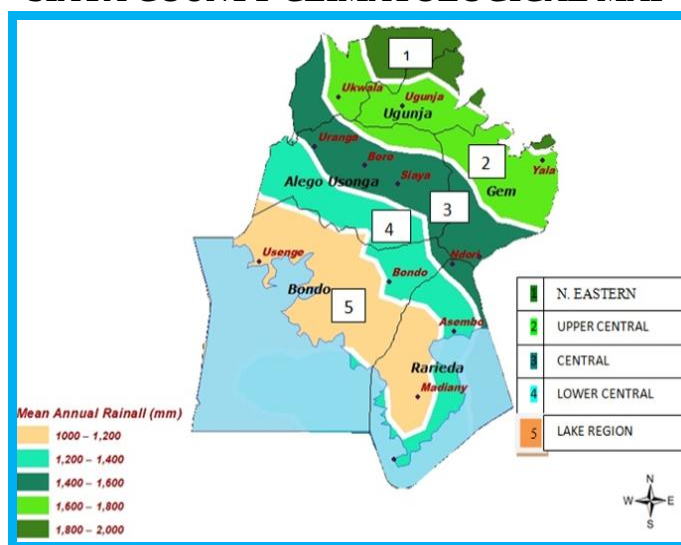


Figure 1; Siaya County Long Term Mean rainfall (Climatological) Map

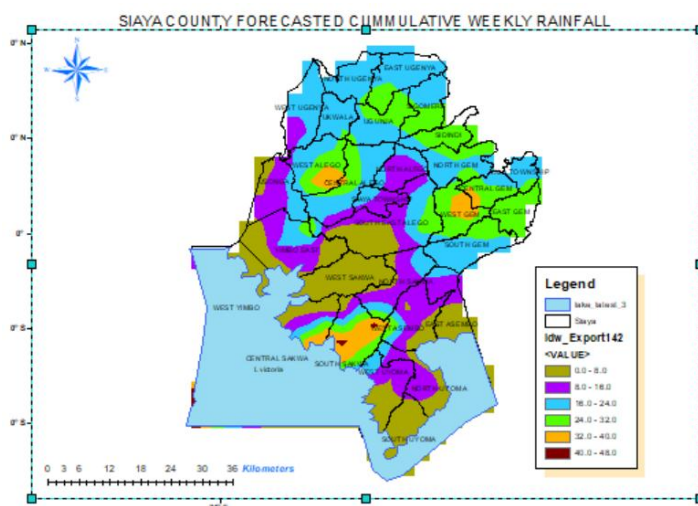


Figure 2: Forecasted cummulative weekly rainfall

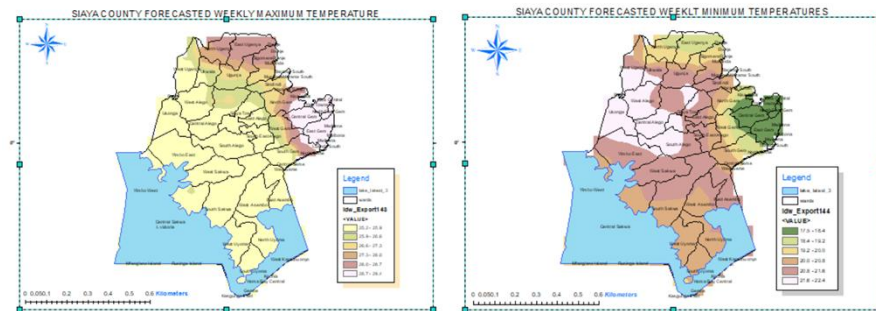


Fig: 3a Forecasted weekly maximum Temp. Fig: 3b Forecasted weekly minimum Temp.

Figure 2 shows the map for forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall. The rainfall is expected to range from 0.0mm to 48.0mm. Most parts of the county are likely to receive between 8.0mm and 48.0mm of rainfall during the forecast period. Some parts of South Sakwa, West Gem and West Alego are likely to experience between 30.0mm and 40.0mm during the forecast period. Figures 3a and 3b shows forecasted weekly maximum and minimum temperatures ranging between 25.2°C and 29.4°C and 17.5°C and 22.4°C respectively

Period of forecast: Tuesday 10th March 2026 to Monday 16th March 2026

Date of issue: Monday 9th March 2026

Summary of The Forecast

Regions; 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5; morning sunny/sunny interval conditions likely throughout the forecast period, afternoon/night shower associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely from Tuesday to Friday. Temperatures of between 28°C and 25°C during the day and between 21°C and 19°C during the night likely. Moderate to Strong winds more so over Lake Victoria likely throughout the forecast period

Hazard Symbols

Green – No hazard warnings in force.

Amber - Potentially dangerous weather is expected. **Be prepared.**

Red – Dangerous and potentially life threatening weather conditions are expected. **Take immediate and appropriate action to ensure your safety.**

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- ✓ Morning sunny/sunny interval conditions likely throughout the forecast period
- ✓ Afternoon/night showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely from Tuesday to Friday
- ✓ Dredging of water tunnels along or around the farms and homes to allow for free flow of surface runoffs
- ✓ Di- silting of pans and dams
- ✓ Clearing of sediment deposits in the culverts and bridges to avoid flooding caused by streams and rivers
- ✓ Installation of lightning arresters to take care of lives and property loss

Advice to farmers from Ministry of Agriculture

- Land preparation in readiness for the long rainy season
- Planting to continue
- Planting of vegetables
- Spraying of animals against pests
- ✚ Consult with your ward crops, livestock and veterinary officer when/wherever necessary
- Report anything unusual to the agriculture or veterinary/livestock experts

Health Advisories (courtesy of One Health Program)

- **Safe drinking water;** Ensure your water source is safe
- **Mosquito protection;** Ensure you sleep under mosquito net or use repellent
- **Proper hygiene;** Maintain good personal hygiene i.e use of toilet and proper washing of hands with clean water.
- **Secure valuables and drugs;** Safeguard important documents and drugs
- **Stay informed;** Stay updated on weather forecast and follow official advisories for real time information
