General Outlook/Summary.

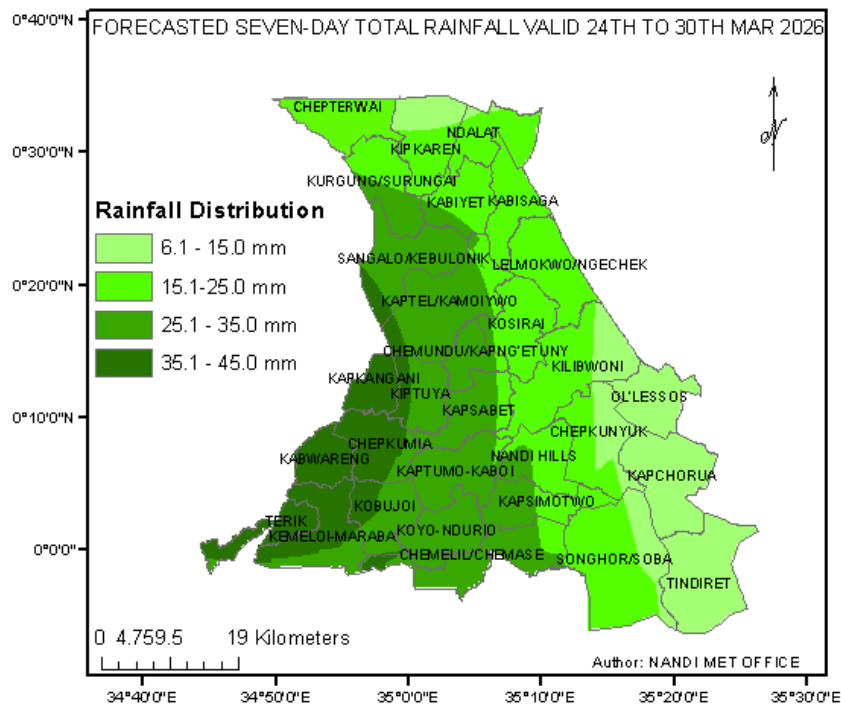





































Figure 1: Forecasted Seven-Day total rainfall valid 24th to 30th Mar 2026

Rainfall is expected to continue many parts of the county during the forecast period (fig 1 below). Temperature range is likely to be between 12-27°C

Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- **Morning sessions:** Mainly sunny conditions expected during the forecast period.
- **Afternoon sessions:** Light to moderate rainfall is expected during the forecast period. Moderate rainfall over many places is likely on Saturday and Monday whereas over few places Tuesday and Wednesday. Light rainfall over few places is likely on Thursday, Friday and Sunday.
- **Nights:** Partly cloudy conditions are expected during the forecast period.
- Maximum temperature ranges likely to be 26-27°C whereas minimum temperatures range likely to be 12°- 14°C during the forecast period

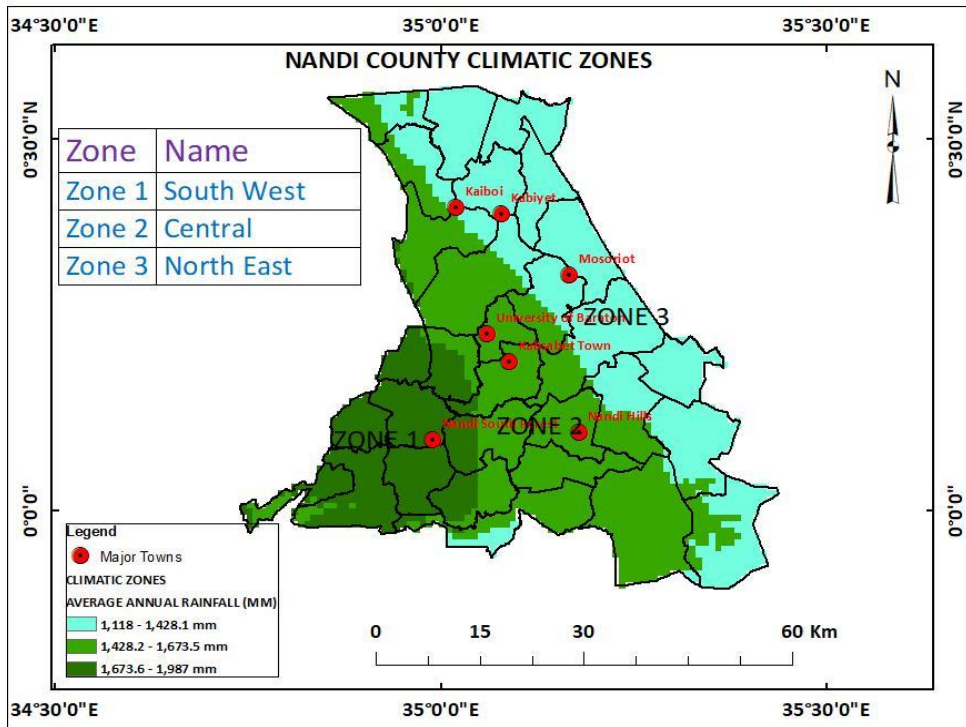


Figure 2: Nandi climatic zones
