



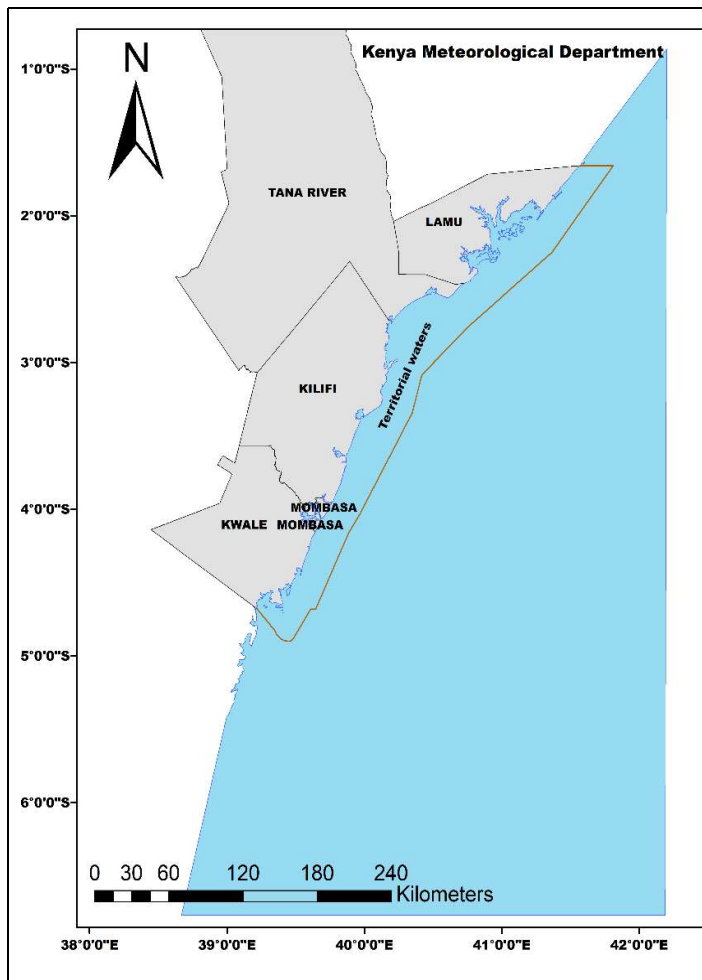

Issued at: 1500 EAT on 4th April, 2026.

Valid: 0000 EAT on 5th April, 2026 to 0000 EAT on 6th April 2026.



GENERAL OUTLOOK

Morning sea state:

- Light to Breezy SE to S winds (04-10knots) with smooth to moderate choppy seas. ESE waves of 2-3ft (0.6-0.9m) with very small mid period waves of (12 sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Afternoon sea state:

- Light ESE to SE winds (07-10knots) with slight choppy seas. ESE to SE waves of 1-2ft (0.3-0.6m) with very small short to very small mid period waves of (9-12sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Visibility:

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST

i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: S 9 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 2 feet at 12 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light S winds with a slight chop. Very small mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: ESE 9 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 1 foot at 12 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light ESE winds with a slight chop. Very small mid period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:24AM** and sunset: **6:27PM**
- Visibility: Moderate (**9-10 km**)
- High Tide: **5:47AM;3.24m, 5:55PM;3.6m**
- Low Tide: **11:42AM;0.45m**

ii. MOMBASA

- Morning Winds: S 8 to 10 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 2 feet at 12 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light S winds with a slight chop. Very small mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SE 9 to 10 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: SE 2 feet at 11 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light SE winds with a slight chop. Very small mid period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:22AM** and sunset: **6:25PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: **5:53AM;3.18m, 6:03PM;3.55m**
- Low Tide: **11:45AM;0.44m**

iii. KILIFI

- Morning Winds: SSE 10 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 3 feet at 12 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Very small mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SE 8 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: SE 2 feet at 11 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light SE winds with a slight chop. Very small mid period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:22AM** and Sunset: **6:25PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **5:43AM;2.84m, 5:51PM;3.22m**
- Low Tide: **11:36AM;0.28m**

iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: SE 4 to 6 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 3 feet at 12 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SE 7 to 10 knots
- Afternoon Waves: SE 2 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light SE winds with a slight chop. Very Small short period waves
- Sunrise: **6:16AM** and Sunset: **6:21PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **5:43AM;2.71m, 5:52PM;3.11m**
- Low Tide: **11:37AM;0.27m**

Advisory

- Slight sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 0.3-0.9m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light to Gentle breeze of 04-10knots expected in Kwale, Mombasa Kilifi and Lamu throughout the forecast period.

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 6 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
