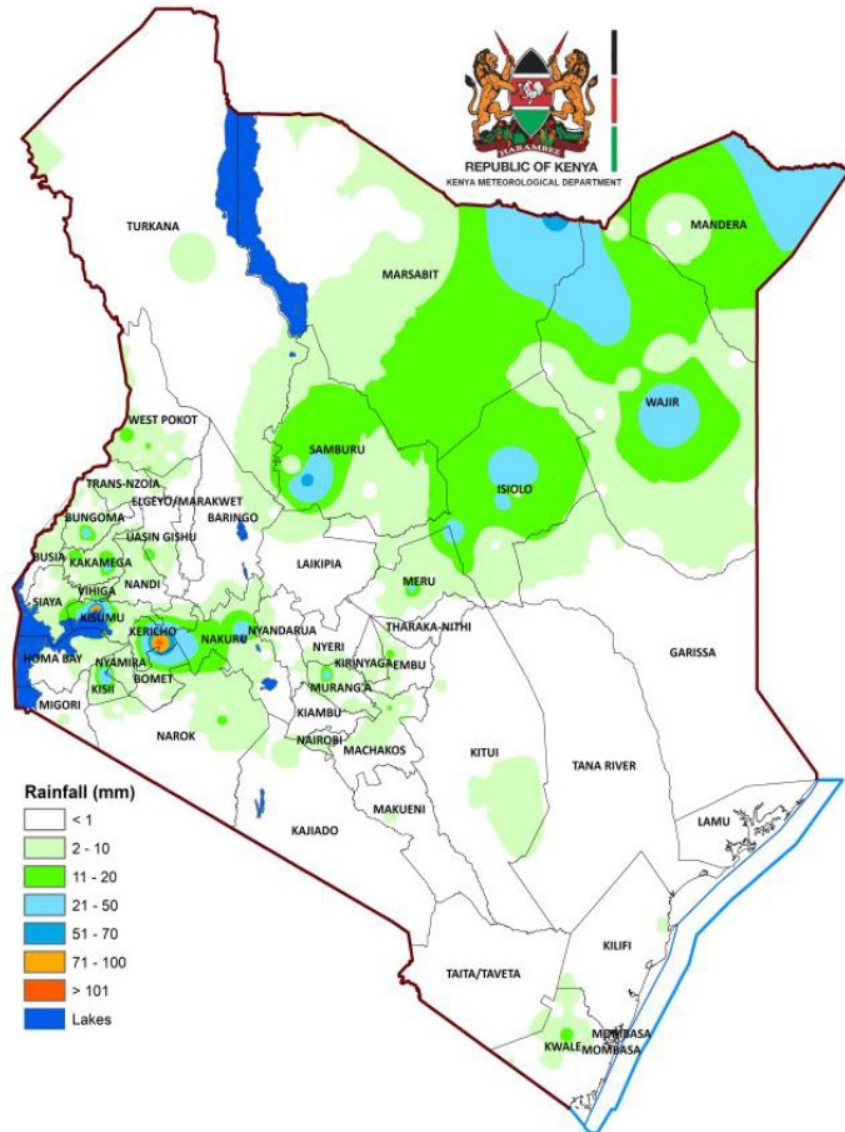

Rainfall Review for to 31st March to 6th April 2026

- Moderate to strong winds was reported in most parts of Marsabit County.
- The Temperatures decreased in most parts of the County during the forecast period.
- Soil moisture was enough for spouting of grass and flowering of trees good for livestock.
- Comparing the 31st March to 6th April 2026 and 24th to 30th March 2026, review periods, it is noted that rainfall amounts decreased in some parts of the county. Marsabit Meteorological station recorded 11.1 mm – 31/3/2026, 3.1mm – 3/4/2026.
- Moyale Meteorological station recorded 34,1mm-31/3/2026, 0.4mm-3/4/2026 and 21.9mm-5/4/2026
- The strength of wind was noted to remain strong as compared to the previous forecasted period.



7 Day Cumulative Rainfall Forecast valid 7th to 13th April 2026 summary

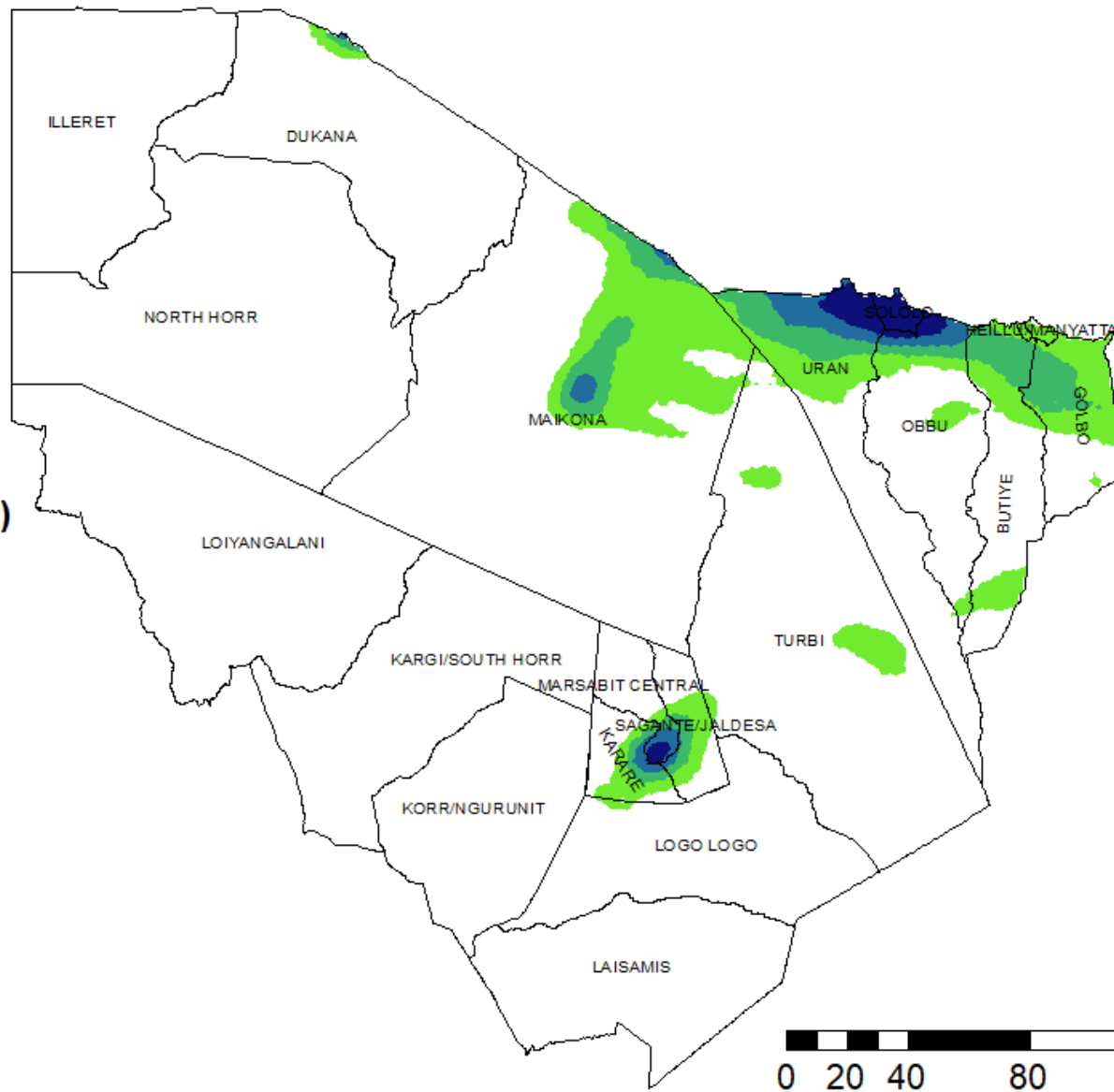
Seven-day weather forecast valid from 7th to 13th April 2026 indicates that Marsabit County is expected to experience generally warm conditions with isolated early-week showers followed by predominantly dry and sunny weather across most areas.

Morning rains as well as afternoon and night showers and thunderstorms are likely to occur over parts of Saku, Uran, Obbu, Butiye, Golbo, Manyatta, Hello and few parts of Maikona Dukana and Ileret in the first half of the forecast as shown on the forecast map below.

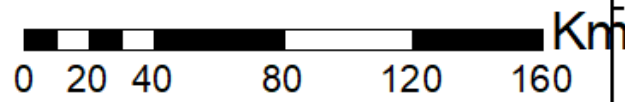
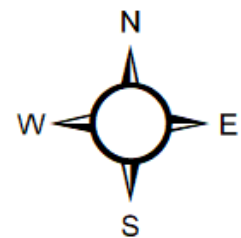
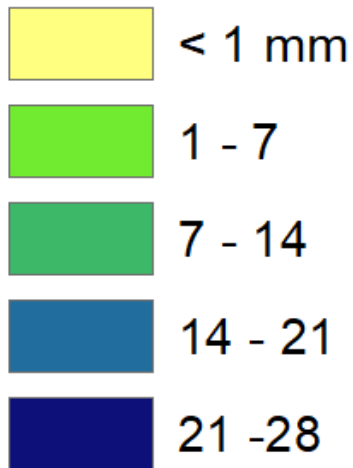
Moderate to strong southerly to south-easterly winds with speeds less than 25 knots (12.9 m/s) are expected over several parts of the County.

Most parts of Loyangarani region are expected to experience very strong winds exceeding 25 knots.

Rainfall Forecast valid 7th to 13th April 2026 summary

(a) Marsabit Central & Saku (Marsabit Town, Karare, Sagante/Jaldesa) is expected to experience partly cloudy with isolated light showers on 7th April 2026, Cloudy intervals, decreasing rainfall will be experienced on 8th – 9th April 2026 while on 10th – 13th April 2026, Sunny to partly cloudy, dry conditions Temperatures: 26°C – 30°C (cooler due to elevation) is expected. Key issue: Occasional fog/mist on Mt. Marsabit and slippery roads early in the week

(b) North Horr Sub-County (North Horr, Dukana, Maikona, Turbi) Mostly dry, slight chance of showers on 7th April; from 8th – 13th April. Hot, sunny, and dry conditions with Temperatures between 30°C – 35°C (very hot days, warm nights) is expected. Key issue: Heat stress and increasing water scarcity

(c) Laisamis Sub-County (Laisamis, Kargi/South Horr, Loiyangalani) is expected to receive Isolated showers in a few areas 7th April 2026, Partly cloudy with occasional sunshine on 8th – 9th April 2026 while dry and windy conditions likely to dominate on 10th – 13th April 2026 with temperatures ranging from 29°C – 33°C. Key issue: Strong winds and dust storms likely.

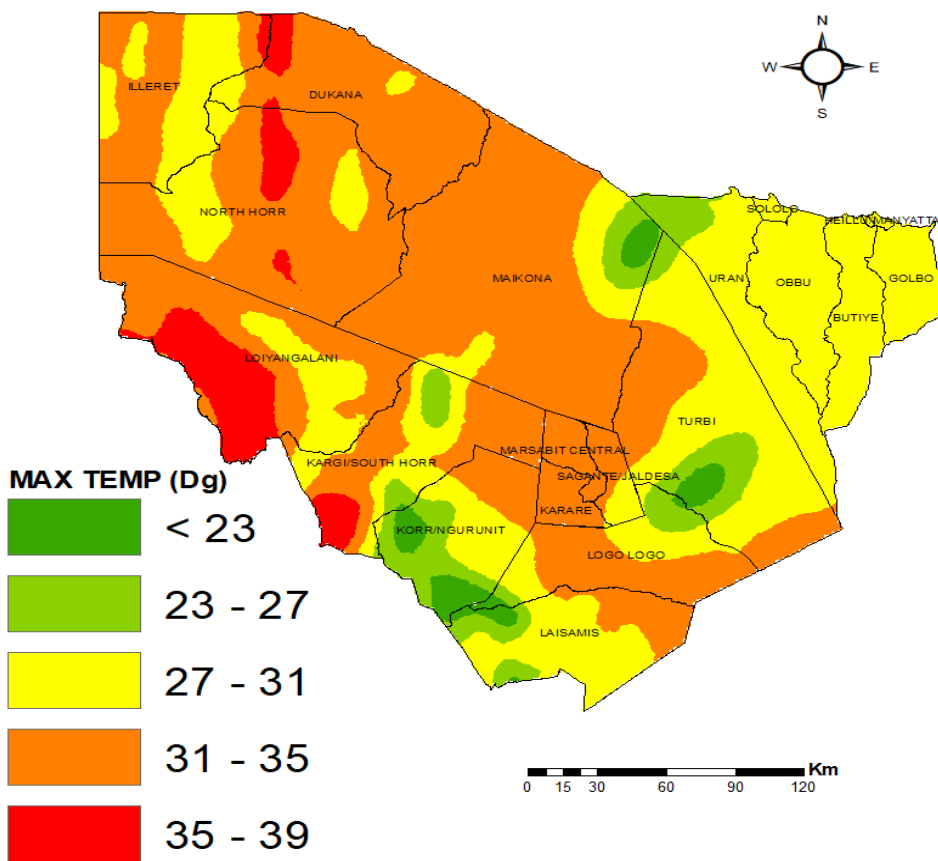
(d) Moyale Sub-County (Moyale, Sololo, Uran, Golbo) 7th April: Light to moderate rainfall likely, 8th – 9th April: Reduced rainfall, cloudy intervals, 10th – 13th April: Dry with sunny intervals, Temperatures: 27°C – 31°C. Key issue: Short-lived rainfall followed by drying conditions

Marsabit Seven Day temperature forecast valid from 7th to 13th April 2026

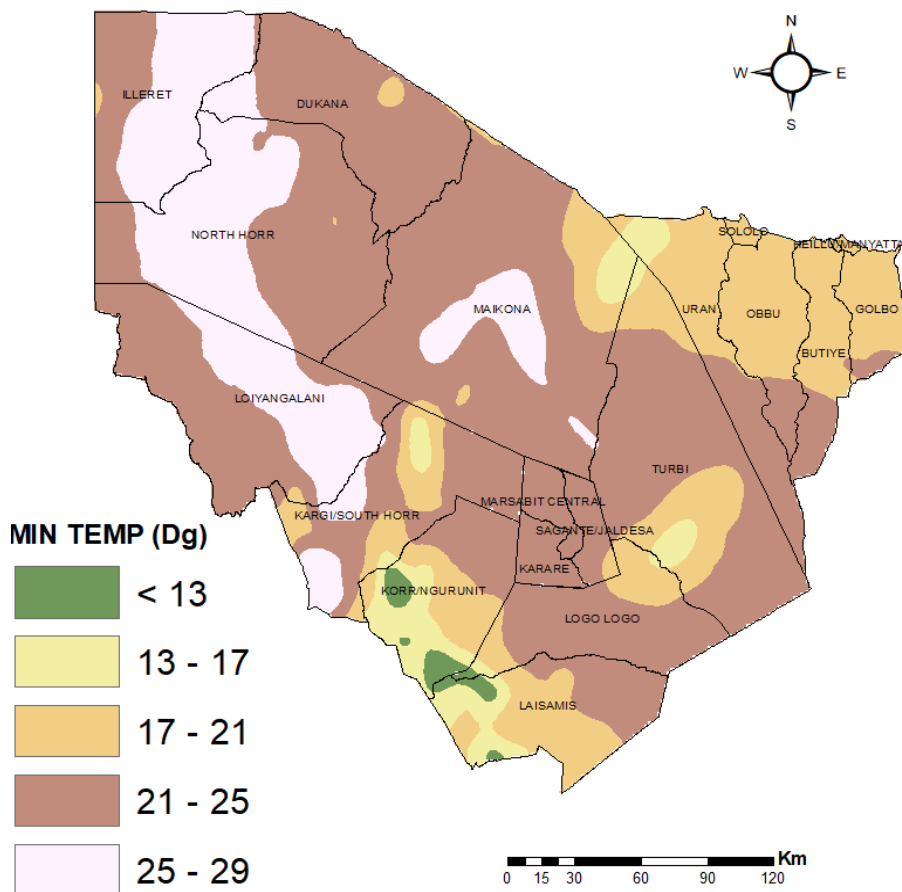
- Average daytime (maximum) temperatures is expected to remain relatively high more than 30 degree Celsius in several parts of the County. Parts around Saku, Obbu, Uran Butiye and Golbo are expected to be slightly cold than other regions in the morning hours (below 30 degree Celsius). Morning fog is expected in morning hours around Mt. Marsabit environs.
- Average night-time (minimum) temperatures will be moderate ranging from 13 to 29 degree Celsius over most parts of the region. Parts around Lake Turkana is expected to receive greater than 25 degree Celsius.

Advisory

- Rainfall is expected to continue across most parts of the County, enhancing pasture regeneration and improving water availability for both domestic and livestock use.
- Communities are encouraged to take advantage of the ongoing rains by harvesting water and conserving fodder for use during upcoming dry spells.
- As the season progresses, occasional episodes of heavy storms are expected; however, there is also an increasing likelihood of short dry spells in some parts of the county.
- Location-specific forecasts for Marsabit County can be obtained from the County Director of Meteorological Services at the Marsabit Meteorological Office.
