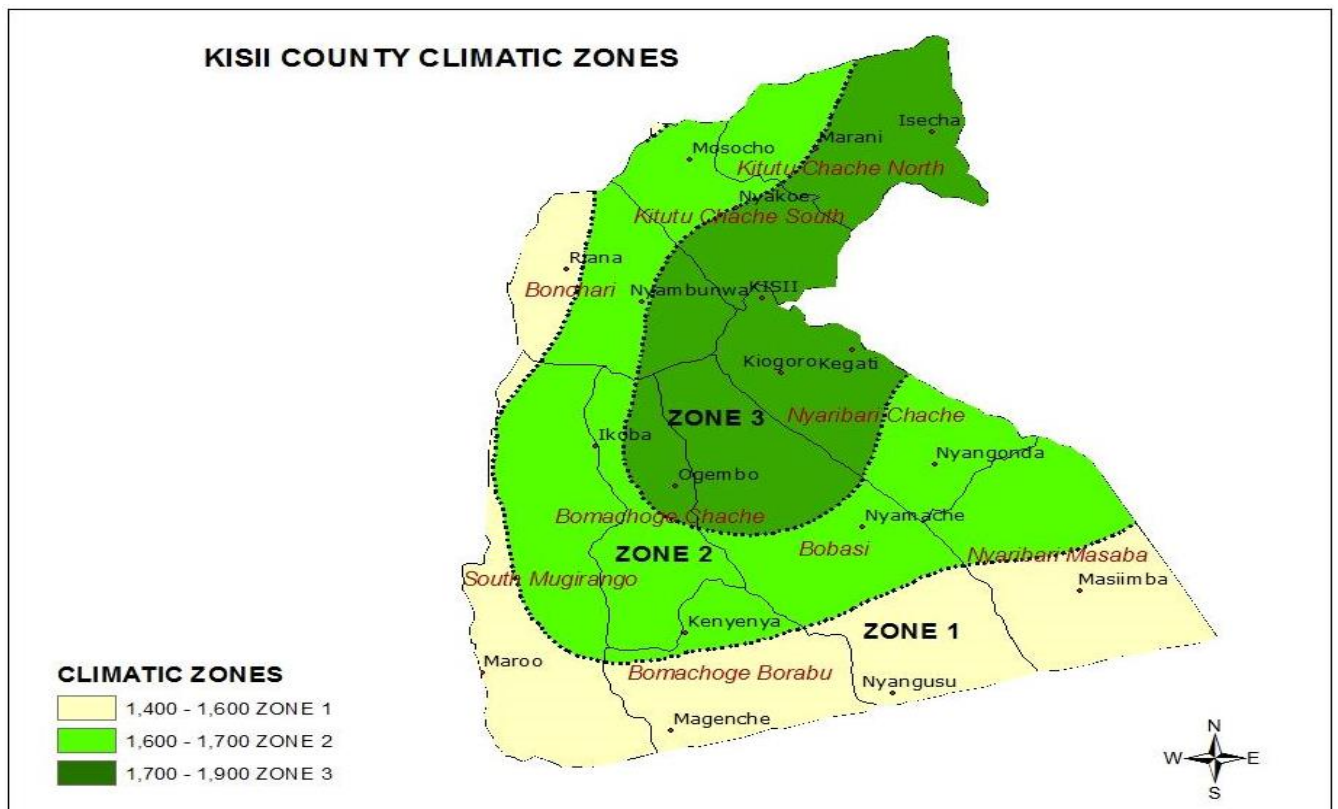
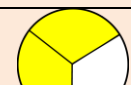
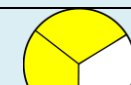
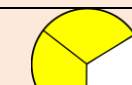
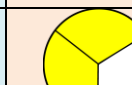


Figure 1: Kisii climatic zones

Kisii County: Weekly Forecast & Safety

1. Rain Forecast

(a) Zone 1

- **Thursday, to Saturday, and Monday:** Light to moderate morning rain in several places, and showers accompanied by thunderstorms in the afternoon /evening over several places. for the whole week

(b) Zone 2

- **Friday to Monday:** Light to moderate morning rain in several places, and showers accompanied by thunderstorms in the afternoon /evening over several places for the whole week.

(3) Zone 3

- **Thursday, Friday, Sunday & Monday:** Light to moderate morning rain in several places, followed by afternoon/evening showers accompanied by thunderstorms in several places for the whole week.

2. Temperature

- **Daytime** Temperatures: (20°C – 27°C).
- **Nighttime** Temperatures: (10°C – 17°C)

3. Safety & Strategy: Essential Guidelines

- **Urban Infrastructure:** Local authorities must prioritize regular drainage maintenance to prevent flash flooding in town centers.
- **Travel Safety:** Use extreme caution on unpaved roads, which become dangerously muddy and slippery when wet. Whether driving or walking, stay alert.
- **Agriculture:** Farmers and fishers should seek professional advice from the Department of Agriculture or Fisheries to protect crops and livestock this season.
- **Mining & Excavation:** Never seek shelter in caves or under overhangs during rain. Saturated soil is highly unstable and can lead to fatal landslides or collapses.

- **Landslide Awareness:** Residents in high-risk areas should monitor the ground for new cracks. If you detect any earth movement, evacuate immediately.
- **Child Safety:** Keep a close watch on children near rivers, ponds, and bridges to prevent drowning accidents.
- **Flood Safety:** Never attempt to cross flowing water on foot or in a vehicle. Even shallow currents can be powerful enough to sweep you away.
- **Public Health:** Maintain high hygiene standards. Healthcare facilities are urged to restock essential supplies now to prepare for a spike in waterborne and respiratory illnesses.
