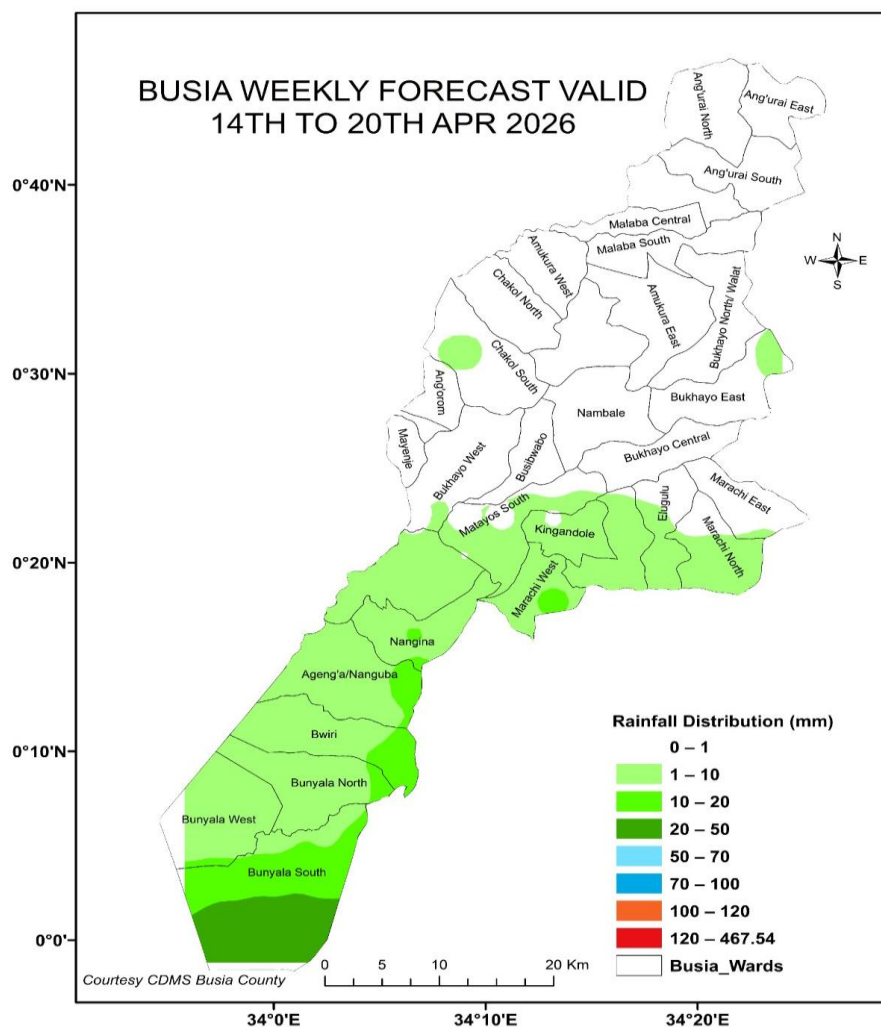

BUSIA COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST



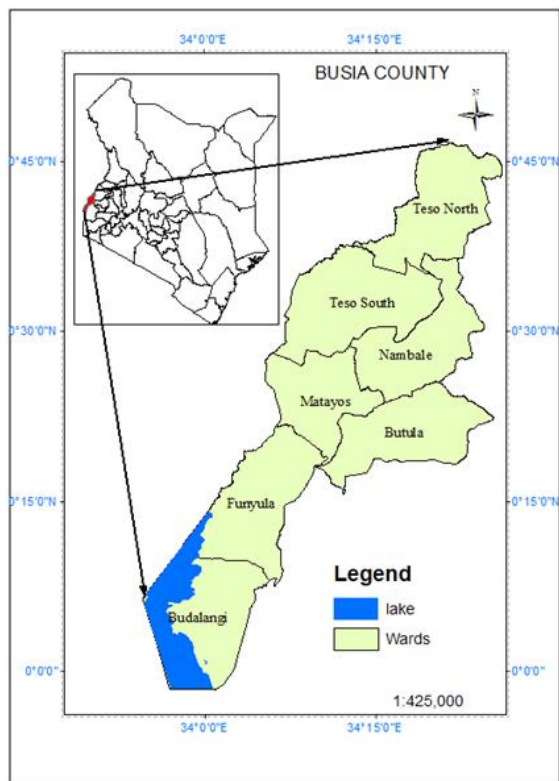
Period of forecast: Tuesday 14th April 2026 to Monday 20th April 2026

Summary

Morning rains may occur over few places on Thursday and Friday. Afternoon showers and thunderstorms expected over few places occasionally spreading to several places. Night showers expected over few places.

Maximum temperatures will range from 24°C to 28°C, with the warmest days expected on Tuesday, Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday. Minimum temperatures will range from 16°C to 19°C. Expect cooler nights than last week.

Key to rainfall space distribution symbols:  No rainfall expected (less than 1% probability),  rain is likely to fall in a **few places** (1-33%),  rain is likely to fall in **many places** (33-67%),  rain is likely to fall in **most places** (more than 67%).

Commentary of County Weather Forecaster:

- Seek shelter in the middle of a building during thunderstorms to stay safe from lightning strikes, strong wind and hailstones.
- Clear drainage channels in farms on Tuesday and Wednesday before possible light to moderate rainfall on Thursday and Friday afternoon.

Apart from Thursday and Friday, the rest of the days of the week are good days to weed farms, apply pesticides and fungicides since they are likely to receive light rains or be dry all day.
