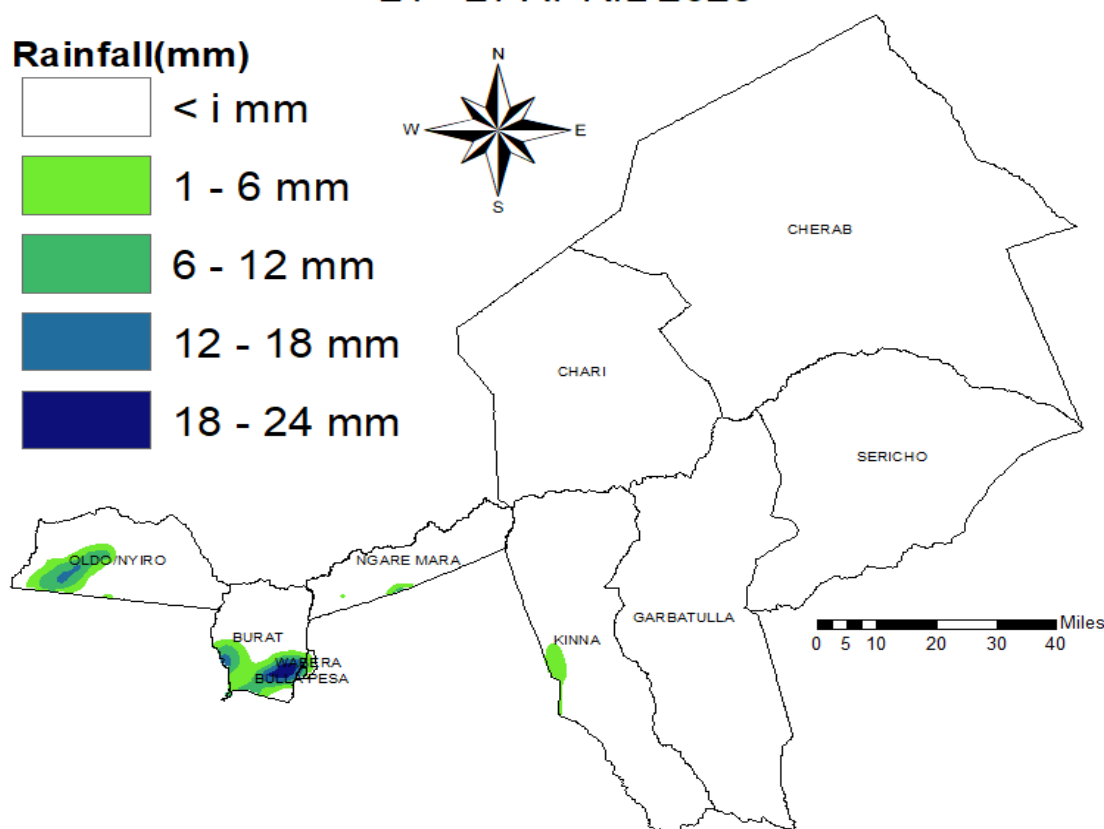
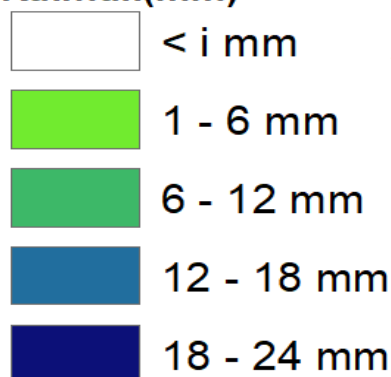

Weekly Weather Forecast for Isiolo County

Valid: 21st – 27th April 2026

Rainfall across Isiolo County during the week is expected to be generally low and unevenly distributed, with most areas receiving little to no rainfall, while a few localized zones experience light to moderate showers.

Forecast Highlights:

Dry Conditions (< 1 mm):

The larger part of the county—including Cherab, Chari, Sericho, and most of Garbatulla—is expected to remain predominantly dry throughout the week.

Light Rainfall (1 – 6 mm):

Isolated areas such as Kinna, Ngaremara, and parts of Oldonyiro may receive light showers, though coverage will be limited and sporadic.

Light to Moderate Rainfall (6 – 12 mm):

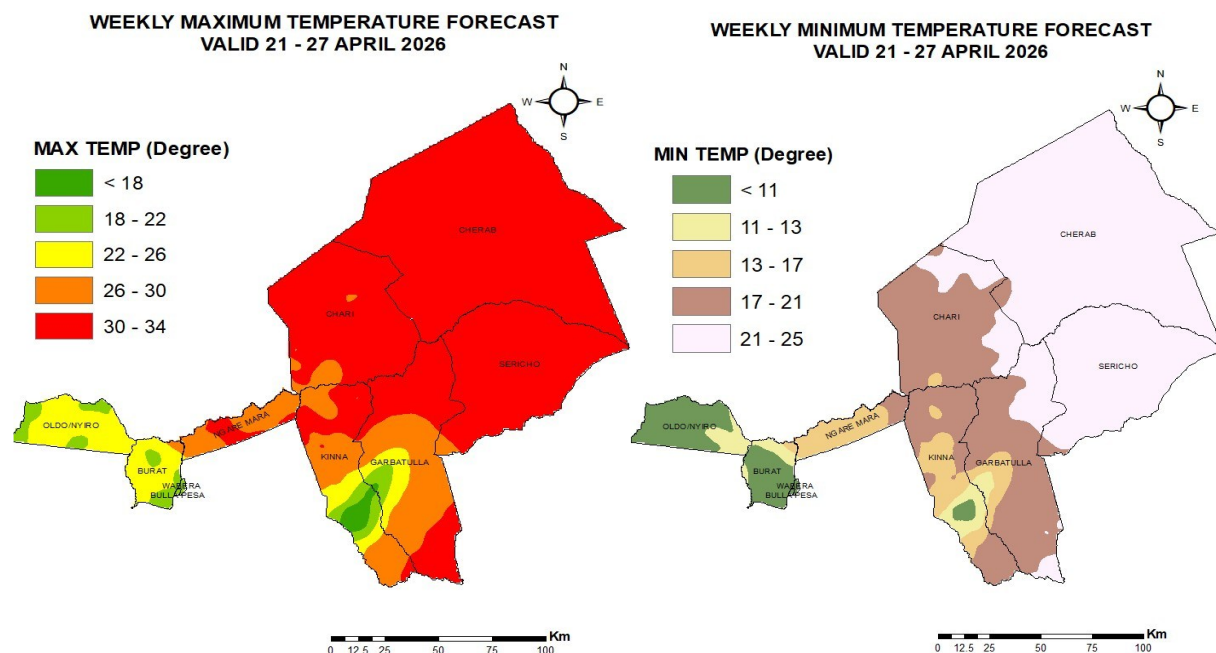
More noticeable rainfall is expected over Wabera, Bulla Pesa, and Burat, with some pockets experiencing slightly higher accumulations within this range.

Moderate Rainfall (12 – 18 mm):

Very localized areas within Wabera and Bulla Pesa may receive moderate rainfall, mainly in short-duration events.

Temperature Forecast Valid: 21st – 27th April 2026 (Isiolo County)

Isiolo County is expected to experience generally high daytime temperatures throughout the forecast period, with most areas recording between 28°C and 34°C.



The hottest conditions are likely in Sericho, Cherab, and parts of Chari, where temperatures may exceed 31°C. In contrast, slightly cooler conditions (25°C – 28°C) are expected in Kinna and parts of Garbatulla.

The coolest daytime temperatures (below 25°C) will be confined to localized areas in southern Garbatulla and Oldonyiro, mainly due to increased cloud cover and rainfall activity.

Nighttime temperatures will vary across the county:

Warm nights (22°C – 25°C): Expected in Sericho and Cherab.

Mild nights (18°C – 22°C): Likely in Garbatulla, Kinna, and Chari.

Cooler nights (11°C – 18°C): Anticipated in Wabera, Bulla Pesa, Burat, and Oldonyiro, making these areas relatively more comfortable.

Residents and stakeholders are advised that rainfall across Isiolo County will be uneven, with few areas receiving light to moderate rains, while a few locations may experience intense but short-lived heavy downpours, particularly in Garbatulla and southeastern Sericho.

Advisory

Residents in areas expected to receive moderate to heavy rainfall should remain alert for flash floods, especially in low-lying areas, seasonal rivers, and poor drainage zones.

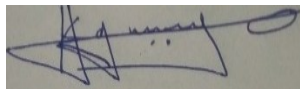
Avoid crossing swollen rivers and water channels during and immediately after heavy rainfall events.

Farmers and pastoralists in areas expecting rainfall are encouraged to take advantage of the moisture for planting and pasture regeneration, though totals remain modest.

Residents in largely dry areas should continue water conservation practices.

Given the localized nature of rainfall, communities should stay updated with daily weather advisories for more precise guidance.
