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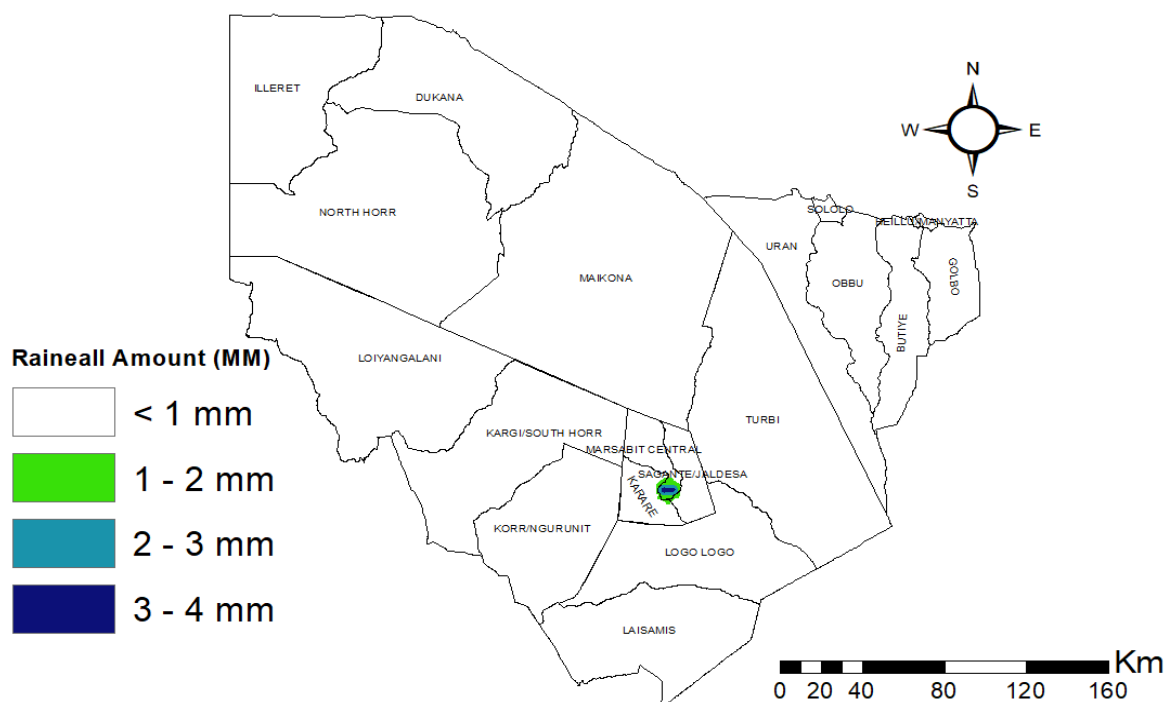

MARSABIT COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST

VALID: 21ST TO 27TH APRIL, 2026.

Date of issue: Monday 20th April 2026

WEEKLY ACCUMULATION RAINFALL FORECAST VALID 20 TO 26 JAN 2026



Marsabit County Weather Forecast (21ST TO 27TH April 2026)

a) Marsabit Central & Saku (Marsabit Town, Karare, Sagante/Jaldesa)

Partly cloudy conditions with a chance of isolated light showers are expected at the beginning of the period (21st - 22nd April). This will transition into cloudy intervals with reducing rainfall on 23rd-24th April. From 25th - 27th April, sunny to partly cloudy and generally dry conditions will prevail.

Temperatures: 26°C – 30°C (relatively cooler due to elevation).

Occasional fog/mist over Mt. Marsabit, leading to reduced visibility and slippery roads, especially in the mornings is expected.

b) North Horr Sub-County (North Horr, Dukana, Maikona, Turbi)

The sub-county is expected to remain mostly dry throughout the forecast period, with only a slight chance of brief showers early in the week (21st April). The rest of the period will be dominated by hot, sunny, and dry conditions.

Temperatures: 30°C – 35°C (very hot days and warm nights).

c) Laisamis Sub-County (Laisamis, Kargi/South Horr, Loiyangalani)

Isolated showers may occur in a few areas at the start of the period (21st - 22nd April). This will be followed by partly cloudy skies with occasional sunshine on 23rd–24th April. From 25th–27th April, dry and windy conditions are likely to dominate.

Temperatures: 29°C – 33°C.

Key Issue: Likelihood of strong winds and dust storms, especially in open areas.

d) Moyale Sub-County (Moyale, Sololo, Uran, Golbo)

The week will begin with a chance of light to moderate rainfall on 21st - 22nd April. This will reduce to cloudy intervals with minimal rainfall on 23rd – 24th April. From 25th - 27th April, conditions are expected to be mostly dry with sunny intervals.

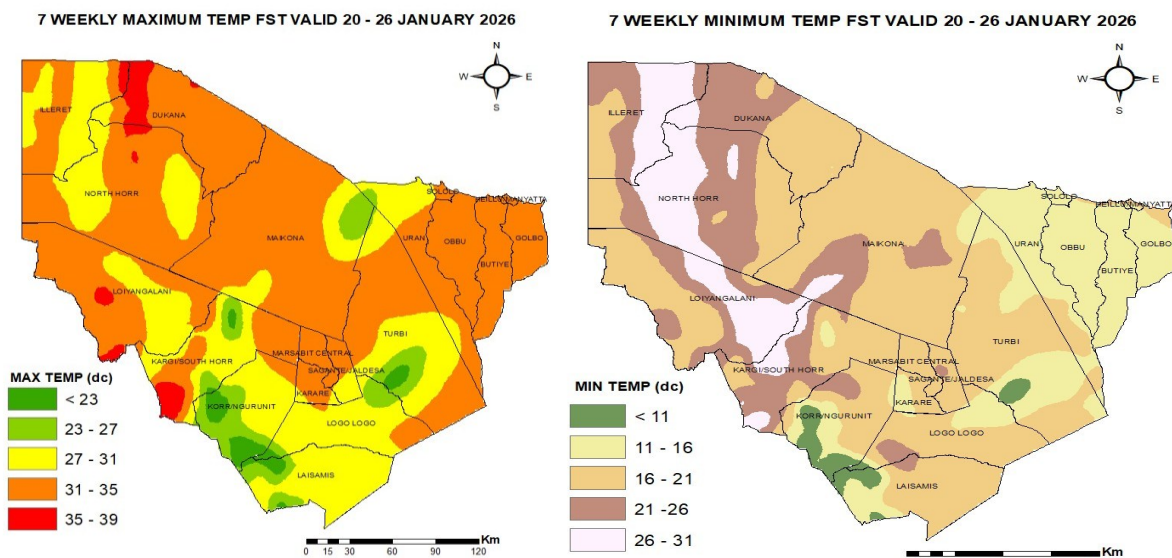
Temperatures: 27°C – 31°C.

Marsabit Seven Day temperature forecast valid from 21st to 27th April 2026

Lowland areas (North Horr, Dukana, Illeret, Loiyangalani, Laisamis, Korr/Ngurunit) is expected to experience hot conditions (30–34°C)

Highland/eastern areas (Sololo, Moyale, Golbo, Obbu, Butiye) will be slightly cooler due to cloudy conditions that may be associated with slight rainfall (24–28°C)

The nights are expected to be generally mild (18–22°C) across the county



Advisory

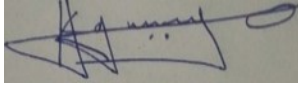
In the eastern and central regions, wet conditions may lead to poor road accessibility, with some routes becoming slippery or impassable. Motorists are urged to exercise caution, consider alternative routes where necessary, and plan their travel in advance to minimize disruptions.

Meanwhile, the rains are expected to improve pasture and water availability in eastern and central parts, offering favorable conditions for livestock.

Northern and southwestern areas will remain hot and dry, and residents are encouraged to stay hydrated, limit exposure to direct sunlight, and ensure adequate water and shade for livestock.

Given the localized nature of rainfall, communities should stay updated with daily weather advisories for more precise guidance.
