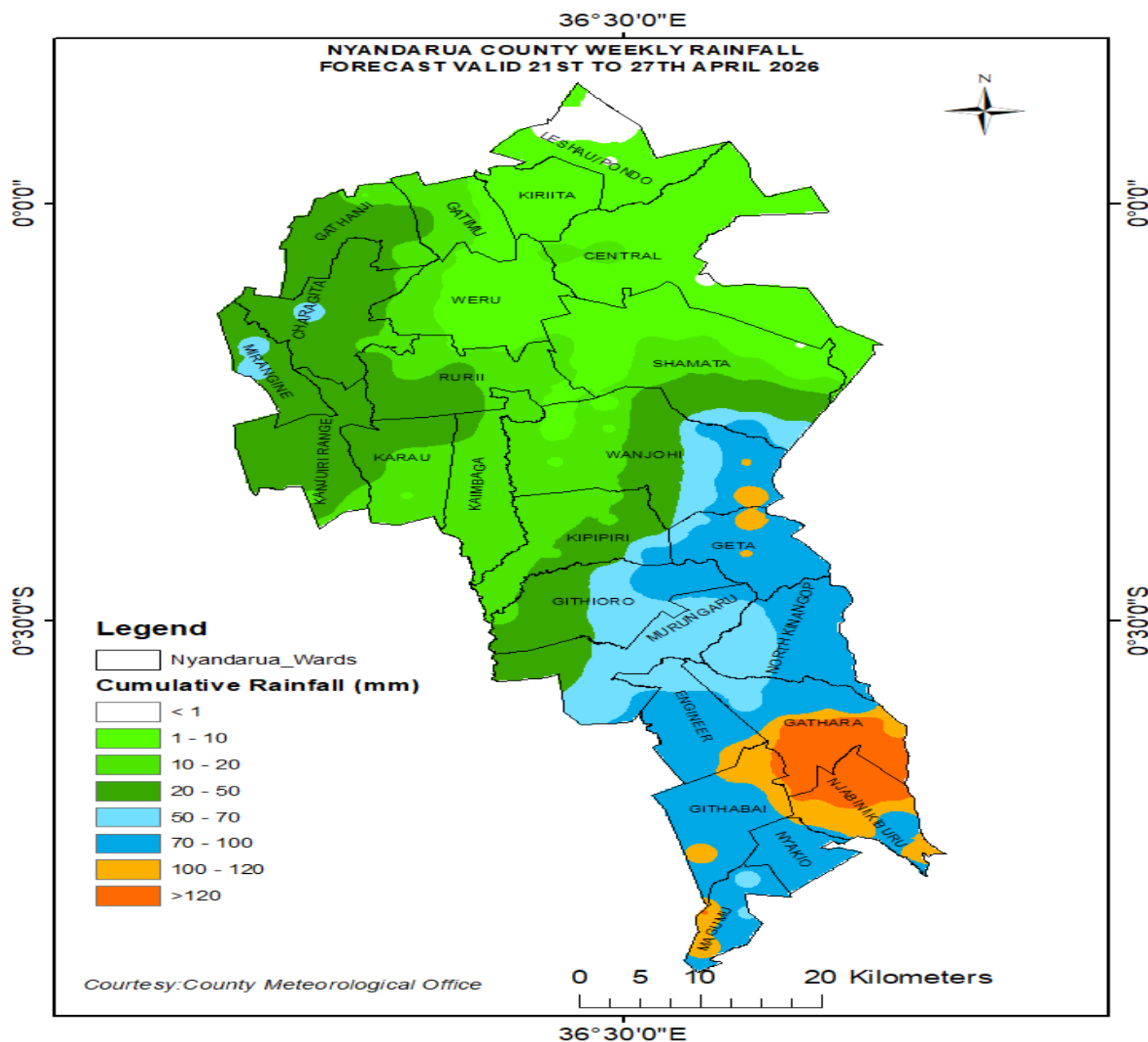

Key to rainfall>Showers distribution:

FEW- : Rainfall is likely to fall in few places (0% to less than 33%),

SEVERAL- : Rainfall is likely to fall in several places (33% to less than 66%),

MOST- : Rainfall is likely to fall in most places (More than 66%).

Summary

- The above figure shows the weekly cumulative volume of rainfall amounts each ward and/or sub-county in Nyandarua County is forecasted to receive from Tuesday 21st to Monday 27th April 2026 (Refer to the legend for details on forecasted amounts).
- Most parts of Kipipiri and Kinangop sub counties are projected to receive the highest weekly cumulative rainfall amounts of above 20mm, with some pockets within Geta, Wanjohi and wards within southern Kinangop likely to receive above 100mm cumulatively for the week.
- The whole of Ndaragwa sub county is projected to receive the lowest amounts of below 20mm cumulatively for the week.
