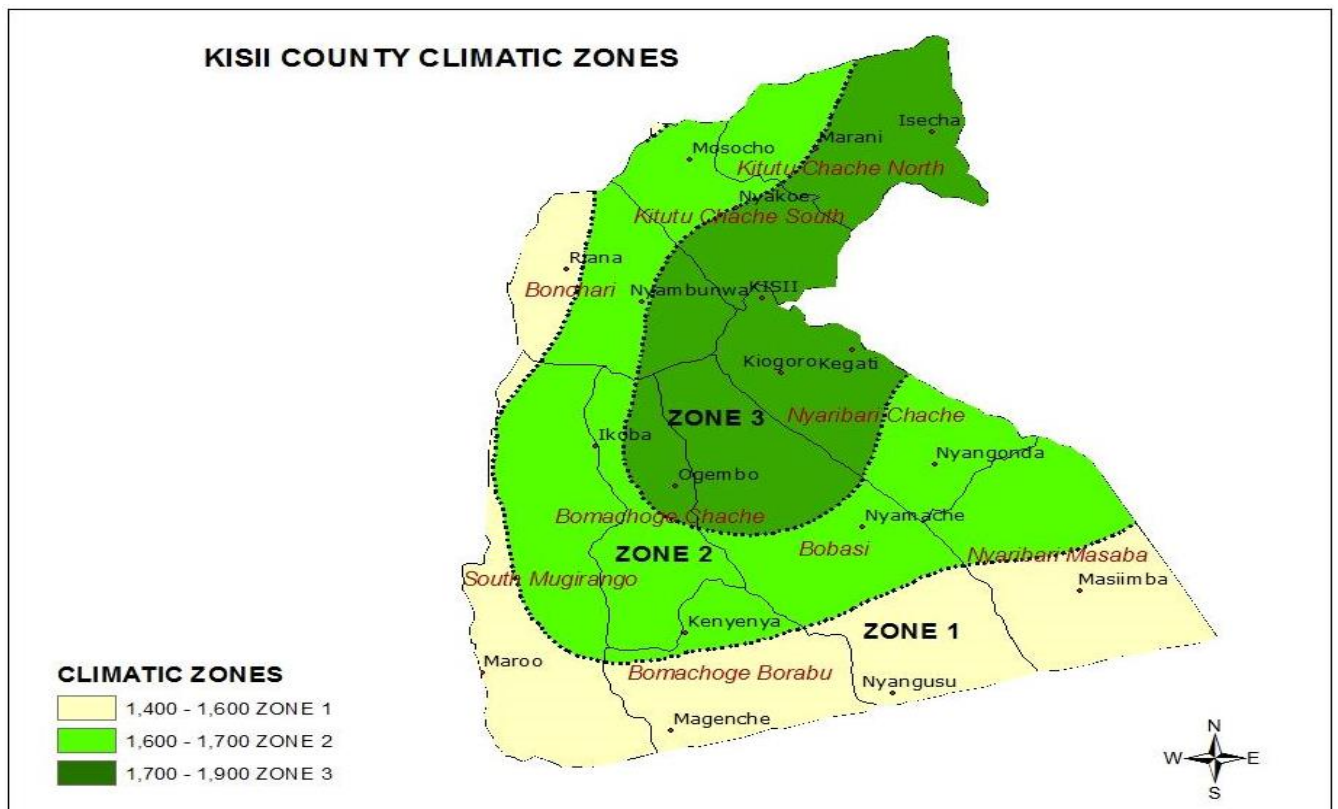
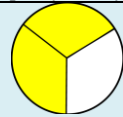
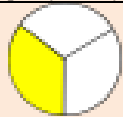
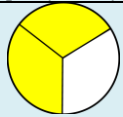
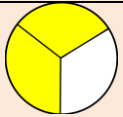
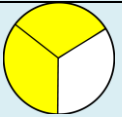
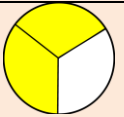
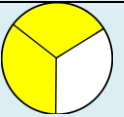


Figure 1: Kisii climatic zones

Kisii County: Weekly Forecast & Safety

1. Rain Forecast

(a) Zone 1

- **Saturday, to Monday:** Light to moderate morning rain in several places, and showers accompanied by thunderstorms in the afternoon /evening over several places for the whole week

(b) Zone 2

- **Thursday to Monday:** Light to moderate morning rain in several places, and showers accompanied by thunderstorms in the afternoon /evening over several places for the whole week except on Wednesday.

(3) Zone 3

- **Thursday, to Monday:** Light to moderate morning rain in several places, followed by afternoon/evening showers accompanied by thunderstorms in several places for the whole week except on Wednesday and Thursday.

2. Temperature

- **Daytime** Temperatures: (19°C – 28°C).
- **Nighttime** Temperatures: (12°C – 19°C)

3. Safety & Strategy: Essential Guidelines

- **Travel Safety:** Exercise extreme caution on unpaved roads, which become dangerously slick and muddy when wet. Remain vigilant whether you are driving or on foot.
- **Agriculture:** Farmers and fishers are advised to consult the Department of Agriculture or Fisheries for professional guidance on protecting crops and livestock this season.
- **Mining & Excavation:** Avoid seeking shelter in caves or under rock overhangs during rain. Saturated soil is highly unstable and poses a severe risk of fatal landslides or structural collapses.
- **Public Health:** Maintain rigorous hygiene standards. Healthcare facilities should restock essential supplies immediately to prepare for a projected increase in waterborne and respiratory illnesses.

- **Flood Safety:** Never attempt to cross flowing water, whether on foot or in a vehicle. Even shallow currents can be powerful enough to sweep you away.
- **Urban Infrastructure:** Local authorities should prioritize the maintenance of drainage systems to mitigate the risk of flash flooding in urban centers.
- **Child Safety:** Closely supervise children near rivers, ponds, and bridges to prevent drowning incidents.
