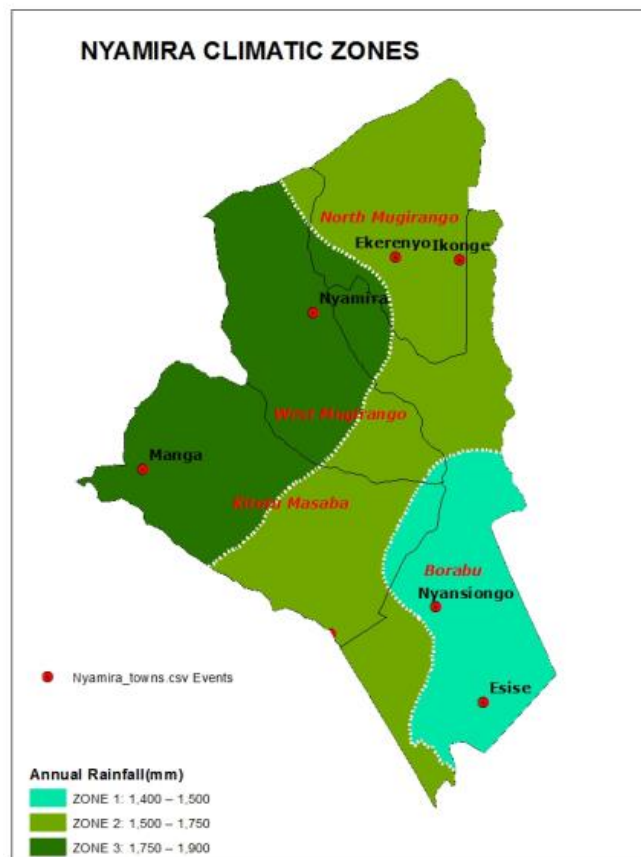


Figure 1: Nyamira climate zones

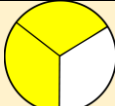

Nyamira County: Weekly Weather & Safety Guide

1. Rain Forecast

(a) Zone 1

- **Thursday, Saturday to Monday:** Light to moderate morning rain in several places, and showers accompanied by thunderstorms in the afternoon/evening over several places for the whole week.

(b) Zone 2

- **Thursday to Monday:** Light to moderate morning rain in several places, and showers accompanied by thunderstorms in the afternoon /evening over several places for the whole week.

(3) Zone 3

- **Thursday to Monday:** Light to moderate morning rain in several places, followed by afternoon/evening showers accompanied by thunderstorms in several places for the whole week except on Wednesday.

2. Temperature

- **Daytime:** Highs between **19°C and 27°C**.
- **Nighttime:** Chilly lows between **12°C and 17°C**.

3. Expert Advice & Safety Precautions

- **Public Health:** Take proactive measures to prevent malaria, typhoid, and influenza. Healthcare facilities are urged to restock essential medicines immediately to manage potential outbreaks.
- **Agriculture:** Farmers should consult the Department of Agriculture for expert guidance on protecting crops and livestock throughout the rainy season.
- **Quarries & Caves:** Never seek shelter in or near caves during rainfall. Saturated soil is highly unstable, significantly increasing the risk of fatal landslides or structural collapses.
- **Road Safety:** Exercise extreme caution whether driving or walking. Rain significantly reduces visibility and creates hazardous, slick road conditions.

- **Lightning Safety:** Stay indoors during thunderstorms. Avoid open fields and never seek shelter under trees. Ensure children remain safely inside until the storm has completely passed.
- **Flood Prevention:** County officials must ensure drainage systems are clear and fully functional to mitigate the risk of flash flooding in urban areas.
- **Water Management:** Capitalize on the increased rainfall by harvesting and storing water to ensure resilience during future dry spells.
