



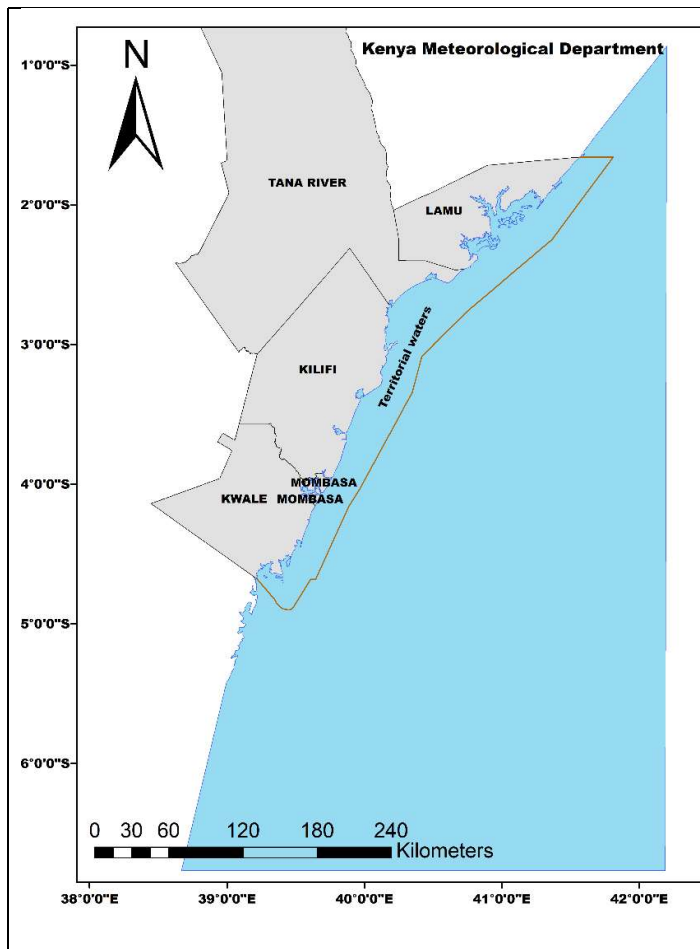

**GENERAL OUTLOOK**

**Morning sea state:**

- Light S to SW winds of (6-12knots) with slight chop seas. ESE waves of 3-4ft 0.9-1.2m with very small to small mid period waves of (10sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

**Afternoon sea state:**

- Light to Breezy SSE to S winds of (10-17knots) with Slight chop to moderate choppy seas. ESE waves of 3-4ft (0.9-1.2m) with Small mid period waves of (11sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

**Visibility:**

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

## COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST

### i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: SW 8 to 9 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 3 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light SW winds with a slight chop. Very small mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 12 to 15 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 3 feet at 11 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small mid period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:21AM** and sunset: **6:20PM**
- Visibility: Moderate (**9-10 km**)
- High Tide: **1:14AM;2.8m,1:52PM;2.94m**
- Low Tide: **7:38AM;0.98m, 8:06PM;0.96m**

### ii. MOMBASA

- Morning Winds: SSW 8 to 12 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 4 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light SSW winds with a slight chop. Small mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: S 11 to 15 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 4feet at 11 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy S winds with moderate choppy seas. Small mid period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:19AM** and sunset: **6:18PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: **1:21AM;2.66m,1:58PM;2.87m**
- Low Tide: **7:37AM;0.98m, 8:11PM;0.96m**

### iii.KILIFI

- Morning Winds: SSW 8 to 12 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 4 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light SSW winds with a slight chop. Small mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: S 11 to 17 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 4 feet at 11 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy S winds with moderate choppy seas. Small mid period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:19AM** and Sunset: **6:18PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **1:15AM;2.41m,1:52PM;2.62m**
- Low Tide: **7:30AM;0.79m, 8:04PM;0.79m**

### iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: S 6 to 7 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 4 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light S winds with a slight chop. Small mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: S 10 to 14 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 4 feet at 11 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light S winds with a slight chop. Small mid period waves
- Sunrise: **6:12AM** and Sunset: **6:15PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **1:14AM;2.3m,1:53PM;2.51m**
- Low Tide: **7:30AM;0.74m,8:05PM;0.76m**

## Advisory

- Slight to Moderate Sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 0.9-1.2m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light breeze to Fresh breeze of 6-17 knots expected in Kwale, Mombasa Kilifi and Lamu throughout the forecast period. **Caution in carrying out marine activities.**

4.1 – 5.5 m (≈ 12.3 – 16.5 ft)	Very Rough	Warning in place and marine activities on hold

### KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 6 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
