

Commentary of County Weather Forecaster:

The weather outlook for the week of April 12th - 18th May 2026, indicates sunny intervals in the morning sessions in the first to days and later on light morning rains over few places the rest of the forecast period. The afternoons will have moderate rains covering several places, occasionally reducing to light rains over few places as the week progresses. The nights will have partly cloudy conditions most of the week with a day of some light rains over few places.

The forecast details are as follows:

- The morning sessions are expected to have sunny intervals on Tuesday and Wednesday. The rest of the mornings to have light rains over few places.
- The afternoons will have moderate rains spread over several places on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Saturday. The rest of the afternoons will experience light rains confined to few places.
- The nights will have light rains are over few places on Saturday. The rest of the nights are expected to have partly cloudy conditions. .
- The weather outlook for the week of 19th – 25th May 2026, indicates that Trans Nzoia County is likely to experience slight reduction in rainfall amounts.
