





























General outlook/ summary

Sunny intervals are expected during the day, with partly cloudy conditions at night. However, morning rains as well as afternoon showers may occur few places.

Expected average maximum temperature of 34°C to 36°C and minimum temperature of 23°C to 26°C

APPENDIX 1: INTERPRETATION OF TERMS USED

Term	Rainfall Amount{24hrs)	Description
Light	< 5 mm	Gentle rain, drizzle.
Moderate	5 - 20 mm	Steady, noticeable rain.
Heavy	21-50m	Intense rain Possible thunder.
Very Heavy	> 50 mm	Prolonged rain.

Term	Rainfall Amount{24hrs)	Description
Few places	< 33%	Rain in small portion of the region.
Several places	33 to 66%	Rain in multiple but not most parts of the region.
Most places	> 66%	Rain in nearly all parts of the region.
