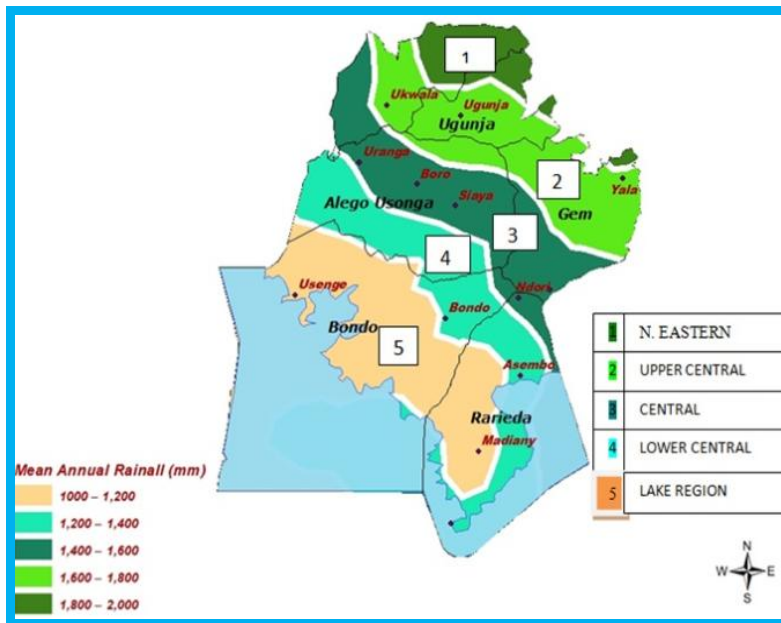


Figure 1; Siaya County Long Term Mean rainfall (Climatological) Map

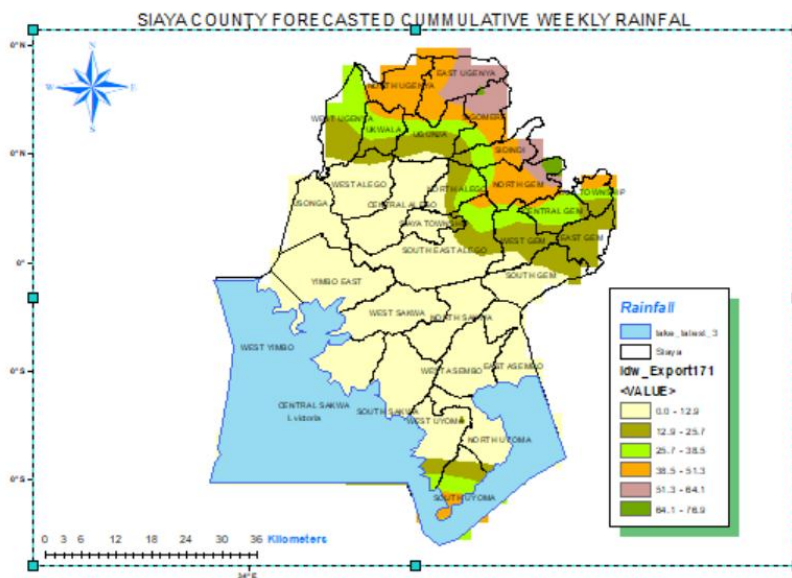


Figure 2: Forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall

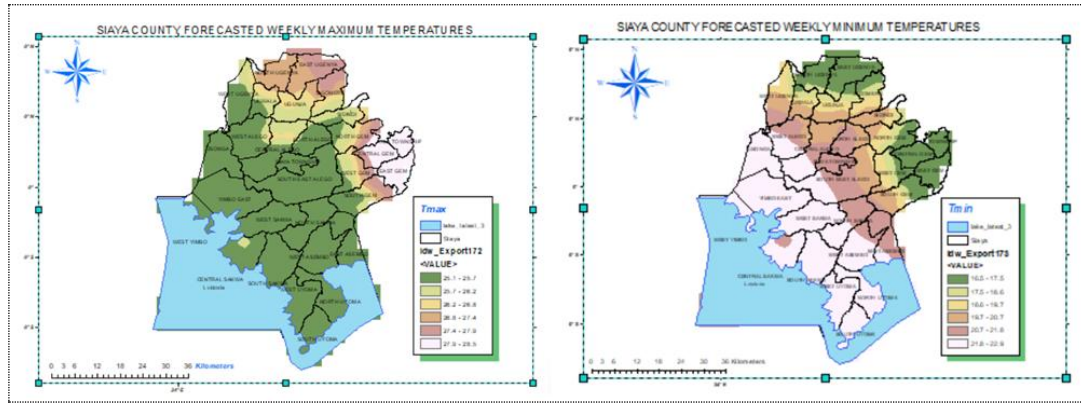


Fig: 3a Forecasted weekly maximum Temp.

Figure 2 shows the map for forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall. The rainfall is expected to range from 0.0mm to 78.9mm. Some areas in the North and North Eastern parts of the County are likely to experience between 25.7mm and 78.9mm. Figures 3a and 3b shows forecasted weekly maximum and minimum temperatures ranging between 25.1°C and 28.5°C and 16.5°C and 22.9°C respectively

**Period of forecast:** Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2026 to Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2026

**Date of issue:** Monday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2026

### Summary of The Forecast

*Regions; 1 & 2; morning shower associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely on Sunday and Monday. Afternoon/night shower associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely throughout the forecast period except on Wednesday. Regions: 3, 4 & 5, morning sunny/sunny interval conditions likely throughout the forecast period. Afternoon/night shower associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely throughout the forecast period except on Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday. Temperatures of between 28°C and 26°C during the day and between 20°C and 18°C during the night likely. Moderate to Strong winds more so over Lake Victoria likely throughout the forecast period*
