SEVEN-DAY WEATHER FORECAST VALID 2ND TO 8TH JUNE 2026

HIGHLIGHTS

Forecast for 2nd to 8th June 2026

- Rainfall is likely to continue over some parts of the county with low amounts during the forecast period.

Weather Review 25th to 31st May 2026

- Rainfall was recorded over some parts of the County during the review period.
- Miyare in Rongo Sub County recorded the highest weekly cumulative rainfall amount of 18.9mm

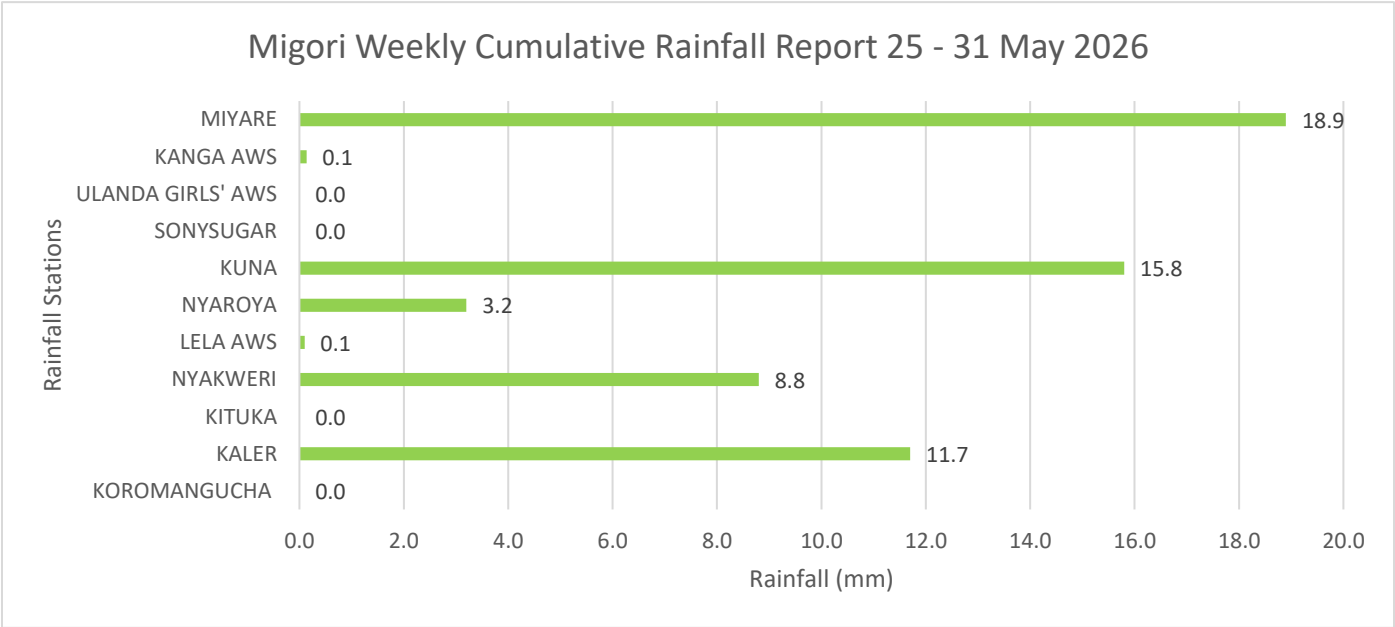

Detailed forecast the regions in table 1 and 2

Sunny intervals expected in the mornings though occasional light rains may occur over few places. Afternoon showers and thunderstorms expected over few places. Nights are likely to be partly cloudy.

Weather Review for 25 - 31 May 2026



- There was a reduction of rainfall amounts and intensities during the review period compared to the previous seven-day period.
- Miyare Rainfall station in Rongo Sub County recorded the highest weekly cumulative rainfall amount of 18.9mm while Kuna (15.8mm) recorded the highest rainfall within 24-hour period of 15.8mm on 30 May 2026. Kaler recorded 11.7mm while the rest of the stations recorded less than 10mm of rain.
