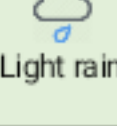
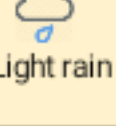
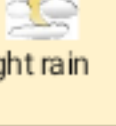
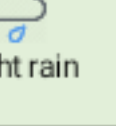
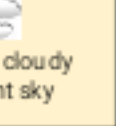
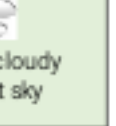
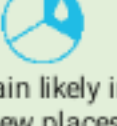
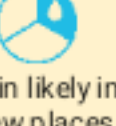
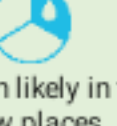
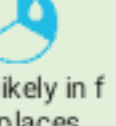
Bura Sub-County and upper part of Tana River Sub-County - Tana River County bordering Kitui, Makueni, Machakos Counties. Sunny intervals are expected during the day, with partly cloudy conditions at night. However, afternoon showers may occur over few places.

Lower part of Tana River Sub-County and Garsen Sub-County;

Occasional morning, afternoon and night showers are expected over few places occasionally spreading to several places

Weak Southwesterly winds exceeding 10 knots (5m/s) expected over Tana River and its ocean area s- delta parts of Kipini and Ozi.
