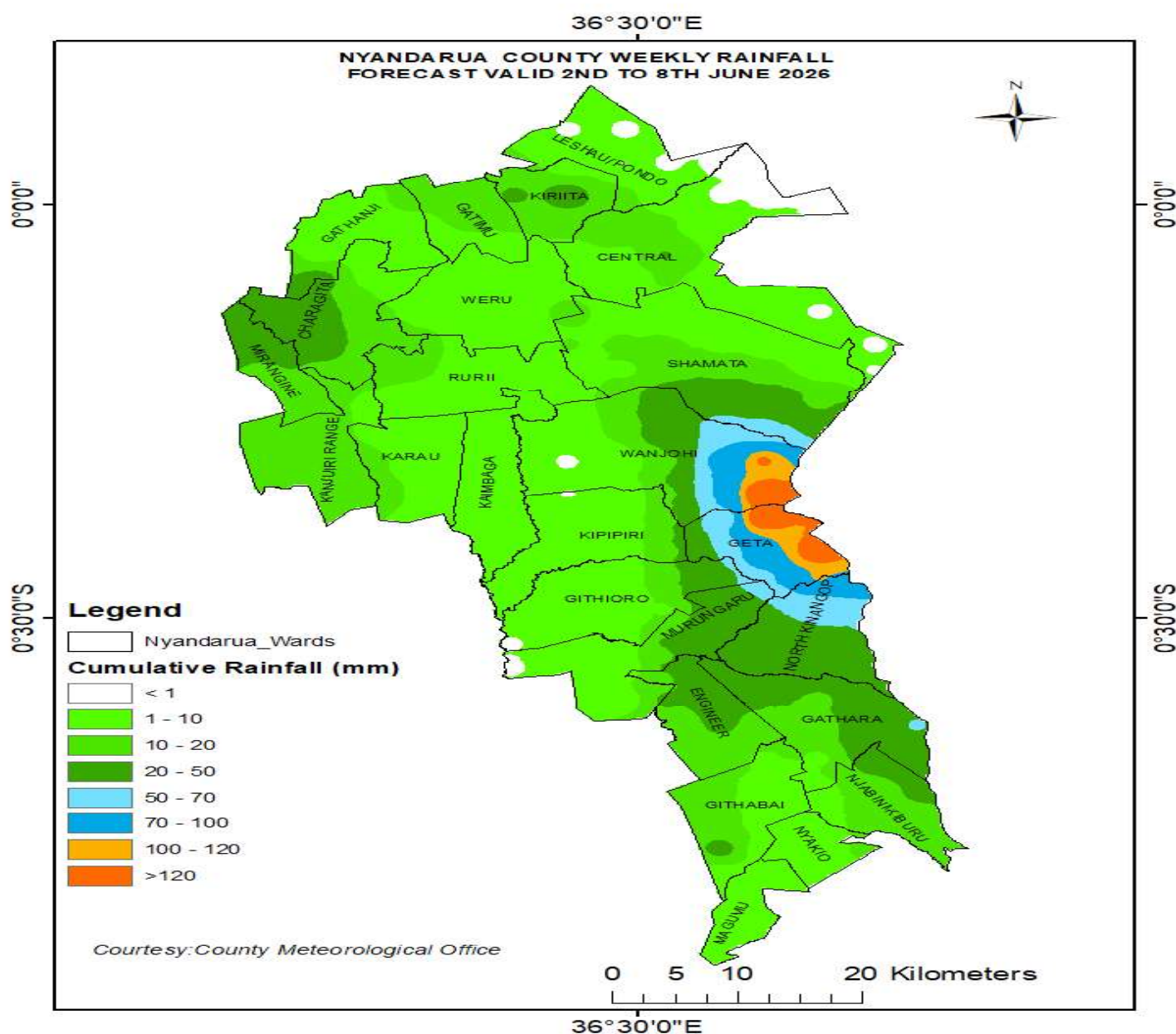
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WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST

Key to rainfall>Showers distribution:

FEW- : Rainfall is likely to fall in few places (0% to less than 33%),

SEVERAL- : Rainfall is likely to fall in several places (33% to less than 66%),

MOST- : Rainfall is likely to fall in most places (More than 66%).

Summary

- The above figure shows the weekly cumulative volume of rainfall amounts each region in Nyandarua County is forecasted to receive from Tuesday 2nd to Monday 8th June 2026. (Refer to the legend/key for details on forecasted amounts).
- Parts of Charagita, Mirangine, Shamata, Wanjohi, Geta, Kipipiri, Githioro, Murungaru, North Kinangop, Gathara, Njabini and Engineer wards are projected to receive the highest weekly cumulative rainfall amounts of above 100mm, with few pockets within Wanjohi and Geta wards likely to receive above 120mm cumulatively for the week.
- Parts of Ndaragwa central, Leshau/Pondo and Wanjohi wards are projected to receive less than 1mm while majority of wards will receive 1mm to 20mm cumulatively for the week.
