



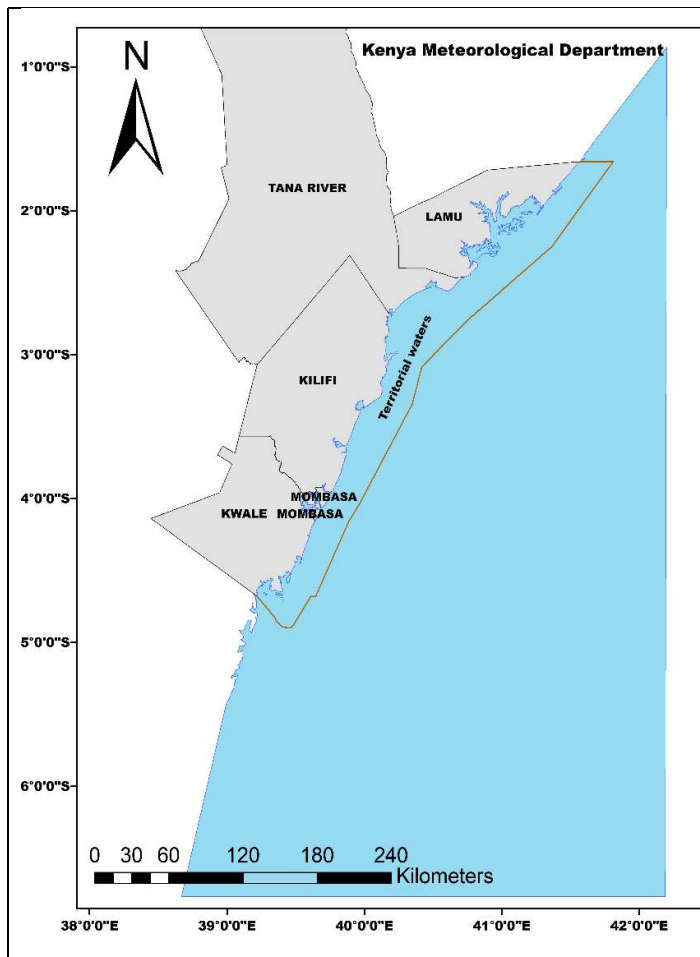

**DAILY MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST FOR KENYAN COAST**

**Issued at: 1500 EAT on 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2026**

**Valid: 0000 EAT on 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2026 to 0000 EAT on 9<sup>th</sup> June, 2026.**



**GENERAL OUTLOOK**

**Morning sea state:**

- Light to breezy S winds (6-17knots) with slight to moderate choppy seas. ESE waves of 3-5ft (0.9-1.5m) with moderate short to mid period waves of (9-10sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

**Afternoon sea state:**

- Light to Breezy SSE winds (9-15knots) with slight to moderate choppy seas. ESE waves of 3-5ft (0.9-1.5m) with moderate short period waves of (8-9sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

**Visibility:**

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

## COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST

### i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: S 6 to 8 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 3 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light S winds with a slight chop. Moderate short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 10 to 12 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 3 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:25AM** and sunset: **6:18PM**
- Visibility: Moderate (**9-10 km**)
- High Tide: **9:42AM;2.61m, 9:52PM;2.55m**
- Low Tide: **3:05AM;1.05m, 3:36PM;1.33m**

### ii. MOMBASA

- Morning Winds: S 8 to 11 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 4 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light S winds with a slight chop. Moderate mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 10 to 13 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 4 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:23AM** and sunset: **6:17PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: **9:36AM;2.56m, 9:43PM;2.53m**  
Low Tide: **3:06AM;0.98m, 3:35PM;1.3m**

### iii. KILIFI

- Morning Winds: S 9 to 12 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 5 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light S winds with a slight chop. Moderate mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 11 to 15 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 5 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:22AM** and Sunset: **6:18PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **9:28AM;2.32m, 9:31PM;2.28m**
- Low Tide: **2:59AM;0.84m, 3:28PM;1.17m**

### iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: S 11 to 17 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 5 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Breezy S winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 9 to 14 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 5 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light SSE winds with a slight chop. Moderate short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:15AM** and Sunset: **6:15PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **9:31AM;2.21m, 9:31AM;2.21m**
- Low Tide: **3:01AM;0.79m, 3:30PM;1.14m**

### Advisory

- Slight to moderate sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 0.9m-1.5m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light to fresh breeze of 6-17knots expected in Kwale, Mombasa Kilifi and Lamu throughout the forecast period. **Small boats and crafts are advised to be cautious while venturing into deep sea areas.**

### KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 6 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
