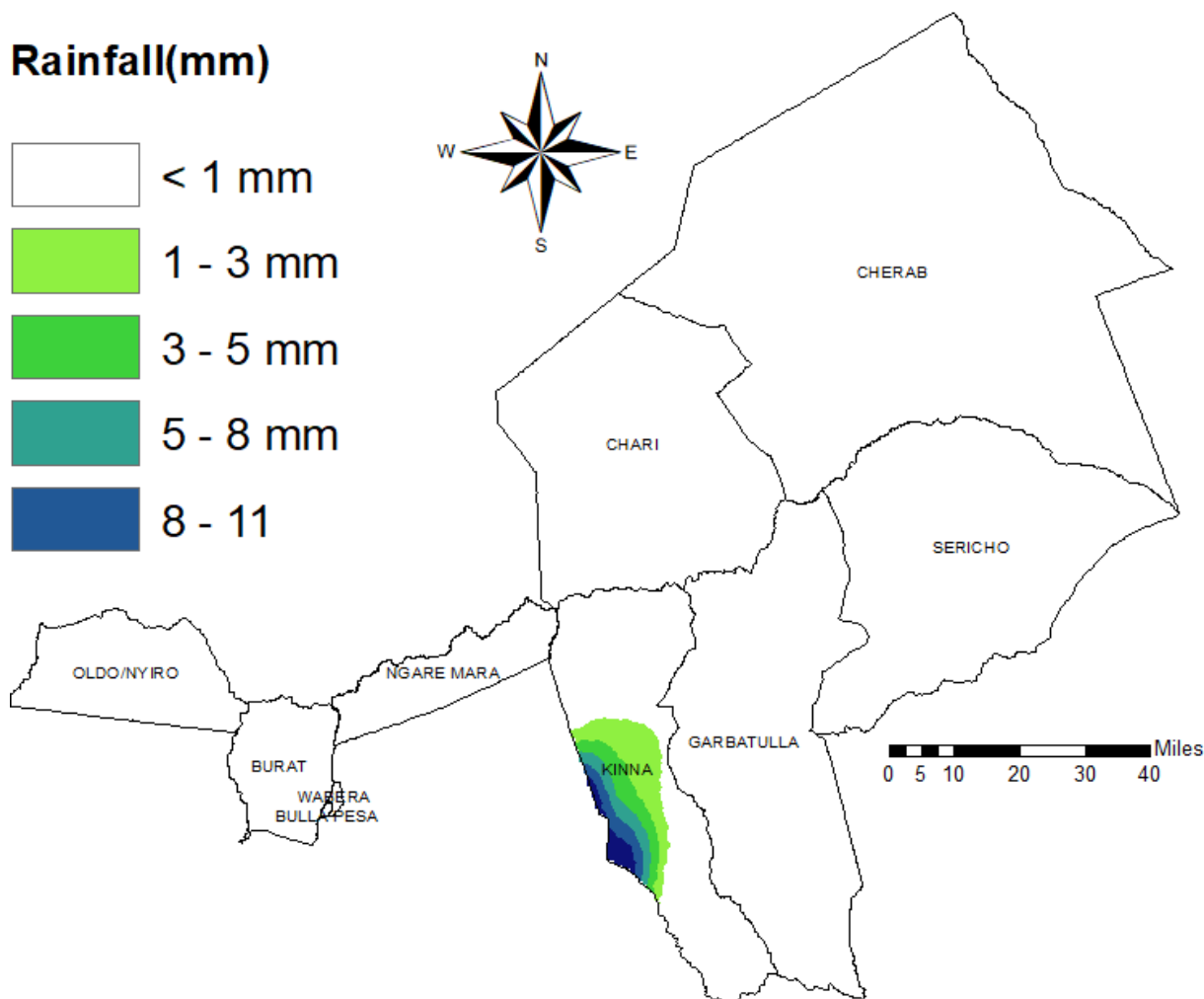
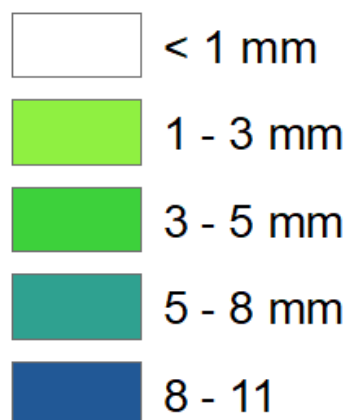
ISIOLO COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST

Isiolo County Weather Outlook (9th – 15th June 2026)

Most parts of Isiolo County are expected to remain generally dry during the forecast period of **9th – 15th June 2026**. Light rainfall is likely to occur in isolated areas around Oldonyiro and a few western sections bordering Laikipia County, while the larger part of the county is expected to receive little or no rainfall.

1. Isiolo Central Sub-County (Isiolo Town, Burat, Oldonyiro)

Isiolo Town, Burat, Wabera, and Bulapesa are expected to experience predominantly sunny, dry, and warm conditions throughout the forecast period. However, localized showers are likely around Oldonyiro and adjacent western areas.

Oldonyiro is expected to receive light rainfall ranging between trace to 1 mm, with occasional cloudy conditions during the week.

Wind Forecast

Moderate winds of approximately 12–25 knots are expected across most areas throughout the forecast period.

2. Garbatulla Sub-County (Garbatulla, Kinna, Sericho)

Garbatulla, Kinna, and Sericho are expected to remain predominantly dry, sunny, and warm, with occasional cloud cover.

Pasture and browse conditions are likely to continue declining gradually due to limited rainfall and persistent dry conditions. Livestock watering points may continue experiencing pressure in some areas.

Wind Forecast

Moderate to strong winds ranging between 15–28 knots are expected, particularly across the open eastern plains, with occasional dusty conditions during the afternoons.

3. Merti Sub-County (Merti, Bulesa, Kom)

Dry weather conditions are expected to prevail across Merti, Bulesa, Kom, and surrounding areas throughout the forecast period.

Skies are likely to remain mostly sunny with no significant rainfall expected. No substantial recharge of water pans or regeneration of pasture is anticipated.

Wind Forecast

Moderate winds of approximately 15–30 knots are expected across much of the sub-county, particularly over exposed dry areas.

4. Ngaremara Areas

Ngaremara and surrounding areas are expected to remain generally dry, although occasional brief light showers may occur.

Wind Forecast

Moderate winds of around 15–25 knots are expected, with occasional stronger gusts.

5. Kinna & Ewaso Nyiro Belt

Most parts of Kinna and the Ewaso Nyiro belt are expected to remain generally dry throughout the forecast period, with rainfall amounts remaining below **1 mm** in most areas.

Water availability along permanent river sections is expected to remain relatively stable, although no significant rainfall-driven recharge is anticipated during the week.

Wind Forecast

Winds ranging between 15–28 knots are expected across the riverine belt and adjacent dry plains.

6. Sericho & Cherab Areas

Sericho, Cherab, and the eastern parts of the county are expected to remain hot, sunny, and dry, with no significant rainfall expected during the forecast period.

Vegetation and pasture conditions may continue deteriorating in some locations, and communities are encouraged to conserve available water resources for domestic and livestock use.

Wind Forecast

Strong winds of around 20–30 knots are expected, especially during afternoon hours. Occasional blowing dust and temporary reduction in visibility may occur in exposed areas.

Temperature Summary (9th – 15th June 2026)

Isiolo County is expected to experience generally warm to hot weather conditions during the period 9th – 15th June 2026, with:

- Daytime temperatures: approximately 25°C to 39°C
- Night-time temperatures: approximately 12°C to 27°C

Expected Temperature Distribution

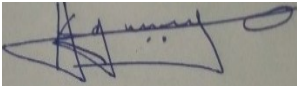
- The hottest conditions are likely over the lowland eastern and northeastern areas, including Sericho, Cherab, Garbatulla, and parts of Merti.
- Relatively cooler temperatures are expected around Oldonyiro and nearby western elevated areas influenced by the Mt. Kenya highlands.

- Most parts of Isiolo Central, Burat, and Kinna are expected to remain moderately hot during the day, with cooler nights in western highland-influenced areas and warmer nights across the eastern lowlands.

Advisory

Residents are advised to continue conserving available water resources and to take precautions against heat stress, particularly in the lowland areas of eastern Isiolo. Livestock owners are encouraged to monitor grazing conditions and plan water access strategically as dry conditions persist across much of the county.
