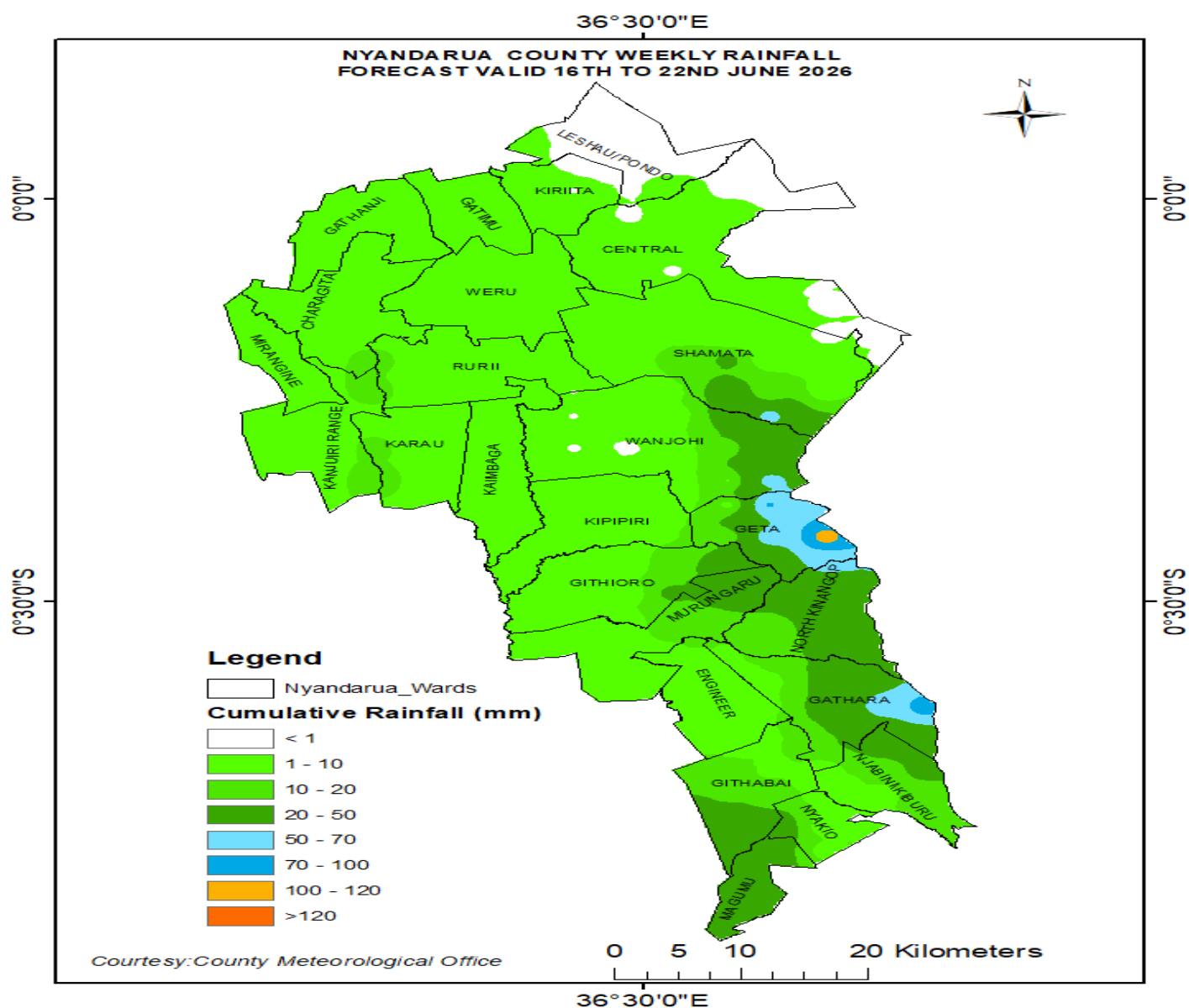

MOST- : Rainfall is likely to fall in most places (More than 66%).

Summary

- The above figure shows the weekly cumulative volume of rainfall amounts each region in Nyandarua County is forecasted to receive from Tuesday 16th to Monday 22nd June 2026. (Refer to the legend/key for details on forecasted amounts).
- Parts of Shamata, Wanjohi, Geta, Githioro, Murungaru, North Kinangop, Gathara, Njabini, Githabai, Nyakio and Magumu wards are projected to receive the highest weekly cumulative rainfall amounts of between 20mm and 50mm with few pockets within Geta and Gathara wards likely to receive between 50mm and 70mm cumulatively for the week.
- Parts of Leshau/Pondo, Kiriita, Ndaragwa central and Shamata wards are projected to receive least amounts of less than 1mm while the rest of wards will receive between 1mm and 20mm cumulatively for the week.
